### The Series

In a series that goes back to 1940, Grinnell holds a 31-27 lead based on the strength of the Pioneers' current five-game win streak in the rivalry. Grinnell is only halfway to the longest win streak in the series. Lawrence won 10 straight from 1941-54.

### Last Meeting

Grinnell hung on for a 34-27 win over Lawrence on Nov. 14, 2015, on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

The game was part of the Midwest Conference Championship Weekend that pitted teams in intra-divisional contests.

Grinnell made a pair of stands deep in its own territory in the final three minutes to preserve the win.

The Pioneers won despite giving up more than 500 yards of offense to Lawrence.

Lawrence quarterback Ryan Butterfield became the first Viking to rush for more than 200 yards in a game since Justin Berrens did it against Ripon College in 2002. Butterfield ran 24 times for 243 yards and three touchdowns. Butterfield also completed 15-of-37 passes for 191 yards.

Lawrence piled up 319 yards on the ground and averaged 7.8 yards per carry. Donnel Haley chipped with nine carries for 65 yards for Lawrence. The Vikings finished with 510 yards of offense.

Grinnell quarterback Sam Poulos was 22-of-36 for 269 yards and five touchdowns.

After a wild first half that saw the teams combine for 61 points, both teams went scoreless in the second half.

Lawrence had a pair of great

scoring chances late in the contest. Butterfield connected with Terrence Simon on a 24-yard pass play to the Grinnell 29-yard line with seven minutes left. Simon then made a fourth-down catch for a short gain to give Lawrence a first down at the Grinnell 17. After a pair of short running plays, Butterfield was unable to connect with Simon on the next two plays and Lawrence turned it over on downs with 2:55 remaining.

The Vikings defense forced a three-and-out and Lawrence got the ball back at the Lawrence 43 with 1:47 left. Butterfield raced for 13 yards and a first down and was hit late out of bounds so 15 more yards were tacked on, giving the Vikings a first down at the Grinnell 32.

On third-and-10, Cole Erickson caught a pass from Butterfield and raced 18 yards to the Grinnell 14. After Butterfield ran to the Grinnell 10, the Vikings were hit with two penalties to move the ball back to the 20.

Out of timeouts, Butterfield went for Simon in the end zone, and despite the fact the defender appeared to hit Simon before the ball arrived, no penalty was called. This came on the heels of the officials picking up a flag for looked to be pass interference in the end zone earlier in the drive.

Facing third down, Butterfield hit Dante Reese for a gain to the Grinnell 10, but the Vikings were unable to run another play before time expired.

### Last Week

Lake Forest scored with 30 seconds left Saturday to pull out a 34-27 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence at Farwell Field.

The Vikings had scored just 26 seconds earlier to tie the game.

Joey Valdivia ran 25 times for 147 yards and two touchdowns to pace Lake Forest. Quarterback Jagan Cleary completed 15-of-27 passes for 208 yards and a touchdown for the Foresters.

Lawrence quarterback Philip Santiago came on in relief and went 12-for-24 passing for 172 yards and a touchdown. He also ran 14 times for 54 yards. Donnel Haley lead the Vikings on the ground with 12 carries for 70 yards.

The Vikings trailed 27-17 heading to the fourth quarter, but Lawrence moved the ball from its own two-yard line all the way to the Lake Forest eight. The big play was a 57-yard pass from Santiago to Cam Boerm to the Foresters' eight-yard line. Boerm finished with four catches for 85 yards.

The drive stalled there, and Pat O'Mahoney kicked a 25-yard field goal to trim the lead to 27-20.

The Foresters punted the ball back to Lawrence, and the Vikings took over at their own eight-yard line. Lawrence moved the ball methodically down the field, but the Vikings were facing a third-and-19 at the Lake Forest 41. Santiago broke away from the rush and scampered 19 yards for a first down.

After coming up inches short of a

first down after a Wasonu Allen catch and run, Santiago plowed ahead on fourth down to give Lawrence a first down at the Lake Forest nine. Santiago then hit Cole Erickson for a touchdown two plays later, and the Vikings tied it at 27-27.

Lake Forest downed the ensuing kickoff at its own 31, and Cleary hit Max Sorby on a 48-yard pass two plays later for a first down at the Lawrence 12. Valdivia ran it in for the touchdown on the next play for the victory.

Lake Forest got a 100-yard kickoff return for a score, and blocked a punt for another touchdown in the

first half. Ryan Butterfield tossed an 18-yard scoring pass to Trevor Spina and ran two yards for another first-half score for the Vikings.

### The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 3-14 (.176).

Jeff Pedersen (Grinnell 2002) is in his seventh season at Grinnell and has a record of 20-47 (.299).

## Vikings Update

►The Vikings are going for program victory No. 500 on Saturday. Lawrence's win over Beloit was 499 in 123 seasons of Lawrence football. Among Midwest Conference teams, only three are in the 500-win club. Monmouth has 552 victories, Ripon has 545 and Cornell has 511. Lawrence has an overall record of 499-465-29. The Vikings have played at least three games every fall since 1893, with the exception of the 1917 when no games were played due to World War I.

►Lawrence won the statistical battle at Lake Forest. In the second time in the last three games against quality opponents, the numbers favored the Vikings. Lawrence had more first downs (23-20), more rushing yards (202-183), more passing yards (229-208) and more total yards (431-391). The Vikings dominated time of possession and had the ball for 36:48, compared to 23:12 for the Foresters.

►Quarterback Philip Santiago (Boynton Beach, Fla./Boca Raton) came on in relief for the final drive of the second quarter and posted some solid numbers against Lake Forest. He completed 12-of-24 passes for 172 yards and a touchdown. Santiago also ran 14 times for 54 yards. On the season, the rookie quarterback is 46-of-98 for 513 yards, two touchdowns and one interception. He also has 44 carries for 253 yards and a touchdown.

►Senior Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./Coronado) is the top receiver for the Vikings with 23 catches for 268 yards and two touchdowns. Spina caught five passes for 56 yards and a touchdown against the Foresters.

►Junior running back Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) put together another solid game and leads the Vikings in rushing. Haley, who carried

12 times for 70 yards for a nice 5.8-yard average against the Foresters, has 66 carries for 321 yards and a touchdown this season. The 70 yards was a season high for Haley.

►Lawrence ranks 10th in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense at 15.6 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in total offense at 313.7 yards per game.

►Round up the usual suspects on defense as linebackers Dan Rothbauer (Appleton, Wis./North) and Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) were the top tacklers against Lake Forest. Rothbauer had nine stops against the Foresters and is tied with Hunter Adams (Franklin, Tenn./Page) for second on the team with 49 tackles. Gostisha made eight stops last Saturday and has a team-high 70 tackles this season.

►Defensive end Cullen Ellis (New

York, N.Y./Beacon) is tops on the squad with 9.0 TFLs and 3.0 sacks. Rothbauer is second with 7.5 TFLs.

►Rookie Terrell Myers Jr. (Marietta, Ga./Marietta) is atop all of NCAA Division III in kickoff returns at 34.7 yards per return. Myers posted a 43-yard return against

Lake Forest this past Saturday and had a 100-yard kickoff return for a score earlier this season. Myers also posted another pass breakup against Lake Forest and has a team-high six on the season.

►Lawrence ranks fourth in the Midwest Conference in total defense at 362.9 yards per game. The Vikings are fifth in scoring defense at 28.1 points per contest.

## Scouting Grinnell

►Grinnell's last game was a 63-0 loss to one of the league's top teams,



Monmouth, back on Oct. 15. The Scots jumped out to a 21-0 lead after the first quarter and pushed the advantage to 49-0 at the half. DeAndre Wright had just four carries but ran for 109 yards and two touchdowns against Grinnell. Monmouth quarterbacks were a perfect 10-for-10 for 274 yards and five touchdowns.

►Quarterback Tony Bergida is 77-of-180 passing for 951 yards, three touchdowns and seven interceptions. He did not play in the loss to Monmouth.

►Running back Jacob Bernholtz leads the team with 69 carries for 389 yards and four touchdowns. He's averaging 5.6 yards per carry.

►The top receiver for the Pioneers is Erik Henderson, who has 26 catches for 315 yards.

►Grinnell ranks last in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 10.3 points per game. The Pioneers are last in the league in total offense at 268 yards per game.

►The Pioneers are last in the league in scoring defense at 50.3 points per game. Grinnell ranks last in total defense at 539.3 yards per game.

►Linebacker Ryan Slager already has more than 100 tackles this season. Slager has 108 tackles for a conference-best 15.4 tackles per game. He also is tied for the team lead with 7.0 TFLs. Hassan Thompson leads the Pioneers at 2.5 sacks.

►Defensive back Max Hill has one of Grinnell's three interceptions this season and leads the team with seven pass breakups.

►Grinnell head coach Jeff Pedersen was a teammate of Lawrence baseball coach Jason Anderson on Grinnell's 1998 Midwest Conference championship team.
