The Series

Macalester holds a 7-4-0 lead in a series that goes back to 1948. Macalester has won three straight in the series, but Lawrence's most memorable win was a 13-10 victory in the Banta Bowl in 2001. The "Immaculate Deflection" game saw the winning touchdown scored by the Vikings in the final seconds when a pass deflected off the shoulder pads of Zach Michael into the waiting arms of Chris McGinley in the end zone.

Last Meeting

Macalester ran for 416 yards on Oct. 24, 2015, and went on to a 35-7 Midwest Conference North Division win over Lawrence on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Zandy Stowell had 25 carries for

193 yards and two touchdowns, and quarterback Alec Beatty ran 13 times for 179 yards for two touchdowns for the Scots.

Lawrence quarterback Ryan Butterfield was 11-for-19 for 75 yards and a touchdown. Jacob Berman caught five passes for 44 yards for the Vikings.

Lawrence's Terrence Simon had five carries for 29 yards, and he had three punt returns for 55 yards.

Linebacker Jacob Lueck had a career-high 17 tackles for Lawrence, and Tony Harth and Dan Rothbauer recorded 11 stops apiece. Harth also had 2.0 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss.

Beatty changed the tone of the game with his speed when he entered at the start of the second quarter. His first run went 73 yards for a touchdown and a 7-0 Macalester lead.

Lawrence was forced to punt on the ensuing possession, but the ball touched the Scots' Trey Johnson and Alic Riedel scooped it up for the

Vikings. Butterfield hit Wes Hetcher with a 19-yard scoring pass on the next play to tie the game at 7-7.

Macalester went 78 yards in 12 plays on the next possession to take back the lead. Beatty ran the final five yards for the score and a 14-7 lead.

Simon had an electric 44-yard punt return early in the third quarter to put Lawrence in business at the Macalester 19-yard line. Macalester came up with a big stop on third down, and Pat O'Mahoney's 40-yard field goal was wide left.

The Scots then had scoring drives of eight and seven plays, all runs, in the third quarter. Beatty scored from three yards out and Stowell had a one-yard plunge and Macalester led 28-7 after three quarters.

The Scots added a fourth-quarter touchdown on Stowell's 22-yard run after Macalester got a short field when a Lawrence fake punt attempt failed.

Last Week

Lawrence piled up 348 yards on the ground Saturday and had two 100-yard rushers in a 36-22 Midwest Conference victory over Beloit on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Lawrence quarterback Ryan Butterfield ran 13 times for 132 yards and two touchdowns and included in that was an 82-yard scoring run. The 82-yard run in the second-longest run play in Lawrence history.

Freshman Wasonu Allen ran 17 times for 108 yards and scored on runs of 29 and 19 yards for the Vikings, and Donnel Haley added 69 yards on 11 carries, including a touchdown.

Mason Dixon led Beloit with 25 carries for 146 yards and a touchdown. Quarterback Danny May completed 19-of-28 passes for 214 yards, a touchdown and an interception. May added 12 carries for 65 yards.

Hunter Adams led the Lawrence defense with 11 tackles, and Jake Gostisha had 10 tackles and a fumble recovery. Dan Rothbauer added eight tackles and picked off a pass for the Vikings.

Lawrence's first touchdown was set up by Terrell Myers' 60-yard kick-off return to the Beloit 26-yard line. It took the Vikings just four plays to score as Butterfield ran it from two yards out for a 7-3 lead.

The Vikings opened the second quarter with a seven-play, 70-yard scoring drive. Allen capped the drive with a 29-yard touchdown run to put the Vikings up 14-6.

Gostisha recovered a fumbled punt return at the Beloit eight-yard line to set up the next score in the second quarter. Haley ran it in on the next play and Lawrence led 22-6. Beloit trimmed the lead to 22-12 at the half when Dixon capped a 10-play, 75-yard drive with a two-yard scoring run with 43 seconds left.

Lawrence took the opening kick-off of the second half and moved 65 yards in seven plays, all runs, for a touchdown. Allen ran it in from 19 yards out, and Lawrence led 29-12.

Butterfield then opened the fourth quarter with the 82-yard run for a touchdown. The play looked like it had a mixup in the backfield, but Butterfield broke outside, split the Beloit defense and went untouched for the score and a 36-15 lead.

The Bucs added a late touchdown on May's 42-yard pass to Michael Nolden.

The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head

coach and has a record of 3-11 (.214). Tony Jennison (UW-Eau Claire 1997) is in his ninth season at Macalester and has a record of 43-41 (.512).

Vikings Update

►The win over Beloit this past Saturday was victory No. 499 in 123 seasons of Lawrence



football. Among Midwest Conference teams, only three are in the 500-win club. Monmouth has 551 victories, Ripon has 545 and Cornell has 511. Lawrence has an overall record of 499-462-29. The Vikings have played

at least three games every fall since 1893, with the exception of the 1917 when no games were played due to World War I.

►The Vikings cranked out 348 rushing yards in the win over Beloit and averaged 7.1 yards per carry against the Bucs. That is the most rushing yards for the Vikings since 370 in a 45-18 victory over Grinnell in 2006. The Vikings now have 798 rushing yards this season and are averaging 4.8 yards per carry, which ranks third in the Midwest Conference. Lawrence is fifth in the league in rushing offense at 199.5 yards per game.

►Quarterback Ryan Butterfield (McDonough, Ga./Strong Rock Christian) and running back Wasonu Allen (Austell, Ga./South Cobb) both topped 100 rushing yards in the win over Beloit. Butterfield carried 13 times for 132 yards and two touchdowns, and Allen carried 17 times for 107 yards and a pair of TDs. It was Allen's first 100-yard rushing game.

►Butterfield had an 82-yard TD run in the victory on the first play of the fourth quarter. That is the second-longest run play in Lawrence history. It is eclipsed only by Adrell Bull-ock's 91-yard run vs. Knox in 2004.

►A big measure of the credit for Lawrence's ground game goes to the young offensive line. Senior tackle Jackson Straughn (Heber City, Utah/Wasatch) is joined by four rookies, Jason Regulski (Suwanee, Ga./Lambert), Juan Marin (Sugar Hill, Ga./Lanier), Gabriel Baker (West Sacramento, Calif./River City) and Andrew Owens (Oklahoma City, Okla./Deer Creek).

►Junior running back Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) is tops on the team in rushing with 39 carries for

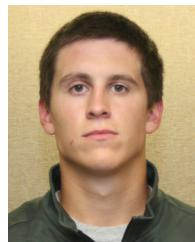

191 yards, an average of 4.9 yards per carry. He chipped in with 69 rushing yards against Beloit.

►Lawrence ranks eighth in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense at 18.8 points per game. The Vikings are 11th in total offense at 295.0 yards per game.

►Sophomore linebacker Hunter Adams (Franklin, Tenn./Page) turned in his biggest game of the season with 11 tackles against Beloit. Adams, who returned from a broken leg last season, is second on the team with 31 tackles.

►Linebacker Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) always seems to pop up wherever the ball is. Gostisha finished with 10 tackles against Beloit and now has a team-high 41 this season. Gostisha, also the team's long snapper, recovered a muffed punt at the Beloit eight-yard

line to set up a Lawrence touchdown. He still wasn't finished on special teams and recovered an onside kick in the final two minutes to seal the victory.

►Both cornerback Nick Ulloa (Burlington, Wis./Catholic Central) and safety Wes Hetcher (Wautoma, Wis./Wautoma) had a pair of pass breakups against Beloit. Hetcher is tied for the team lead with fellow safety Dante Reese (Hanceville, Ala./Hanceville) with four pass breakups.

►Lawrence picked up yet another interception, its sixth of the season, against Beloit when linebacker Dan Rothbauer (Appleton, Wis./North) picked off a pass in the first half. Rothbauer put together a fine game with eight tackles and now has 28 on the season.

►Defensive end Cullen Ellis (New York, N.Y./Beacon) had eight tackles, including 1.5 TFLs and 0.5 sacks, against Beloit.

Ellis now has 18 tackles this season and leads the team in both TFLs (6.0) and sacks (3.0).

►Lawrence ranks third in the Midwest Conference in total defense at 325.0 yards per game. The Vikings are third in scoring defense at 21.0 points per contest.

Scouting Macalester

►The Scots stayed unbeaten in Midwest Conference play with a 16-8 victory over Ripon last Saturday. Macalester built a 16-0 before Ripon scored late. The Scots recovered the onside kick and ran out the clock.



►The Macalester attack is triggered by quarterback Cody Petrich, who has completed 67-of-127 passes for 883 yards, four touchdowns and one interception. Petrich also has 27 carries for 61 yards. Quarterback Christian Adams also has seen action and has completed 28-of-63 passes for 494 yards, four TDs and six interceptions.

►Jacob Jones is the top rusher for the Scots with 70 carries for 267 yards and one TD. Garrett Eichhorn and Alec Beatty are the top receivers for the Scots. Eichhorn has 22 catches for 436 yards and two TDs, and Beatty has 24 catches for 404 yards and seven TDs.

►The Scots rank sixth in the league in scoring offense at 26.4 points per game, and Macalester is fourth in total offense at 423.2 yards per game.

►Macalester ranks second in scoring defense at just 17.4 points per game. The Scots are second in total defense at 324.6 yards per contest.

►Defensive back Miles Kiante and linebacker Phil Wettersten lead the team with 44 tackles apiece. Defensive lineman Nick Egersdorf leads the team with 8.0 sacks and 8.5 TFLs.
