The Series

In one of the oldest series on the books, Lawrence holds a 58-37-5 advantage. The teams have split the last six games in the series, which dates to 1899. At one point, Lawrence won 11 consecutive meetings and 18 of 20 in a stretch from 1966 to 1987.

Last Meeting

Beloit ran out to a big early lead and went on to a 49-34 Midwest Conference North Division victory over Lawrence on Sept. 19, 2015, at Strong Stadium.

Mason Dixon ran 19 times for 218 yards and three touchdowns, including a 77-yard scamper, to lead Beloit. Beloit quarterback Danny May was 13-of-19 passing for 233 yards and

four touchdowns.

Lawrence quarterback Ryan Butterfield was 12-of-17 for 140 yards and three touchdowns. He also ran five times for 54 yards.

Trevor Spina caught seven passes for 94 yards, and Jacob Berman had six catches for 88 yards. Spina, Berman and Cam Boerm all caught touchdown passes for the Vikings.

The Bucs scored three times in the first 8:43 to rush out to a 21-0 lead. Lawrence got on the board on Donnel Haley's two-yard touchdown run in the second quarter but trailed 42-7 at the half.

The Vikings trailed 49-7 before putting up 27 points in the final quarter. Corey Fisher had a nine-yard scoring run, and Butterfield then threw touchdown passes of 25, 16 and 34 yards to complete the scoring.

Last Week

Illinois College jumped out to a 17-point lead at the half Saturday

and went on to a 40-15 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Illinois College quarterback Drew Chance went 19-for-29 for 258 yards, three touchdowns and one interception. Austin Ellsworth caught nine passes for 181 yards and a score for the Blueboys.

Jason Barbour led the Illinois College ground game with 17 carries for 104 yards and a touchdown.

Quarterback Ryan Butterfield was 8-for-14 for 110 yards and a touchdown for Lawrence. He also led the Vikings with three carries for 36 yards. Backup quarterback Philip Santiago played most of the second half and went 5-for-10 for 28 yards, and he ran four times for 32 yards.

Lawrence rookie return man Terrell Myers posted a 100-yard kick-

off return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter. It is the second-longest kickoff return in Lawrence history, eclipsed only by the 102-yard return by College Football Hall of Famer Scott Reppert vs. UW-Oshkosh in 1982.

Linebackers Jake Gostisha and Hunter Adams had big days for the Vikings. Gostisha had 14 tackles, including a tackle for loss, and his third interception of the season. Adams tied for game-high honors with 14 tackles.

Mixed in among a spate of penalties to start the game, Illinois College moved 76 yards in 14 plays for the game's first touchdown. Chance then hit Ellsworth for a 75-yard scoring pass on the Blueboys' next drive for a 14-0 lead.

The Blueboys led 17-0 when the Vikings went on an 81-yard scoring drive. Butterfield hit Trevor Spina on a wide receiver screen, and Spina cut across the field and went 61 yards for the touchdown to cut the lead to 17-7.

Illinois College ended the half on a 14-play, 75-yard drive, with Barbour scoring from a yard out, to grab a 24-7 lead at the half.

The Blueboys scored on their first drive of the second half for a 30-7 lead, and Zack DeWitt added a 42-yard field goal for a 33-7 edge early in the fourth quarter.

DeWitt's kickoff went to the goal line where it was caught by Dan Rothbauer, who handed it to Myers. Myers cut left and then right and streaked to the end zone to trim the lead to 33-15 after the two-point conversion.

The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 2-11 (.154). Seth Duerr (Wooster

2000) is in his third season at Beloit and has a record of 8-16 (.333).

Vikings Update

►The Vikings are ending a rare three-game home stand with home games against Finlandia, Illinois College and Beloit



sandwiched around the bye week. The last time Lawrence played back-to-back-to-back home games was 2005 when the Vikings finished the campaign with consecutive games in the Banta Bowl against Grinnell, Lake Forest and Illinois College.

►Rookie defensive back Terrell Myers Jr., (Marietta, Ga./Marietta) tied the re-

cord for the longest kickoff return in a Midwest Conference game and was named the league's Special Teams Player of the Week. Myers' 100-yard kickoff return against Illinois College ties the record held by Beloit's Tim Thompson (vs. Lake Forest 1980) and Monmouth's Ray Brooks (vs. Carleton 1951). It ranks as the second-longest kickoff return in Lawrence history, trailing only the 102-yard return by College Football Hall of Famer Scott Reppert vs. UW-Oshkosh in 1982.

► This marks the second consecutive season Lawrence has returned a kickoff for a touchdown. Alic Riedel (Appleton, Wis./East) returned a kickoff for a touchdown in the 2015 season opener against Rockford. The last time that happened was 2009 and 2010. Nate Nelson returned a kickoff 73 yards for a score vs. Knox in 2009, and Sam Wagner had an 88-yard return for a TD against St. Scholastica in 2010.

► Junior running back Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) is tops on the team in rushing with 28 carries for 122 yards, an average of 4.4 yards per carry. He ranks 14th in the league at 40.7 rushing yards per game.

► Lawrence's two quarterbacks have split the playing time throughout the season. Sophomore Ryan Butterfield (McDonough, Ga./Strong Rock Christian) has completed 22-of-44 passes for 239 yards, two touchdowns and one interception. Butterfield also has 17 carries for 46 yards. Rookie Philip Santiago (Boynton Beach, Fla./Boca Raton) is 12-for-26 for 110 yards and one interception. Santiago has 13 carries for 88 yards.

► Senior Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./Coronado) had a 61-yard touchdown catch against Illinois College and leads the team with 12



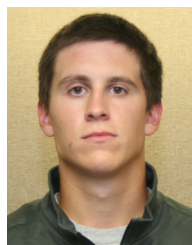

catches for 162 yards, an average of 13.5 yards per catch.

► Lawrence ranks 10th in the league in scoring offense 13.0 points per game. The Vikings are 11th in total offense at 266.3 yards per game.

► Junior linebacker Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) had another big game this past Saturday and has established himself as one of the Midwest Conference's premier defenders. Gostisha posted a career-high 14 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Illinois College. That topped his previous career high of 13, set against Ripon in 2015. Gostisha also made a diving interception, his third of the season. Gostisha leads the Midwest Conference in interceptions and ranks seventh in NCAA Division III at 1.0 interceptions per game.

► Lawrence ranks second in the Midwest Conference in total defense at

292.3 yards per game. The Vikings are third in scoring defense at 20.7 points per contest.

Scouting Beloit

► The Bucs are coming off a difficult 46-41 loss to Cornell in Beloit's homecoming game last Saturday. The Rams scored on a 70-yard pass from Daniel Brown to Riley Bell with just 1:26 left to take the lead for good. Beloit had led 21-0 midway through the second quarter, and running back Mason Dixon finished with 27 carries for 103 yards and three touchdowns for the Bucs.



► Running back Mason Dixon is second on the team in rushing with 39 carries for 234 yards, an average of 6.0 yards per carry.

► Quarterback Danny May is leading the Bucs with his arm and his legs. May ranks third in the league in rushing with 44 carries for 340 yards, an average of 7.7 yards per carry, and four touchdowns. May has completed

69-of-109 passes for 955 yards, nine touchdowns and three interceptions. He ranks third in the league at 250.3 passing yards per game.

►The top receiver for the Bucs is Michael Nolden, who has grabbed 25 passes for 397 yards and five touchdowns.

►Beloit ranks first in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 43.8 points per game. The Bucs popped for 72 points vs. Grinnell earlier this season. The Bucs are second in total offense at 499.5 yards per game.

►Senior linebacker Danny Quijas is tops on the team in tackles with 31 and has 3.0 TFLs. Senior defensive lineman Riley Pearson is tops on the team with 6.0 TFLs and 2.5 sacks as part of his 27-tackle total.

►Beloit is 10th in the league in total defense at 534.3 yards per game. The Bucs are seventh in scoring defense, allowing 32.3 points per game.
