The Series

In a series that goes back to 1935, Lawrence holds a 36-23-2 advantage over the Prairie Fire. The Vikings hold an 8-5 edge in the series since the 2003 season, but Knox has won the last two meetings. Lawrence has scored more than 60 points twice against Knox. The Vikings posted a school-record 67 points against Knox back in 1981 and scored 62 at Knox in 2011 in a game that featured a Lawrence record 573 passing yards.

Last Meeting

A big play jump-started the Knox offense and a long scoring drive sealed the Prairie Fire's 20-6 non-conference win over Lawrence on Sept. 26, 2015, on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Knox got a 79-yard run on the

second play of third quarter to set up its first touchdown, and the Prairie Fire went on a drive that ate up 7:10 of the fourth quarter to grab a two-touchdown lead.

Nick Edlund ran 20 times for 156 yards, and Jared Zanger scored all three touchdowns for Knox.

Lawrence quarterback Ryan Butterfield was 7-for-14 for 80 yards and ran seven times for 35 yards. Quarterback Kemani Pittman was 7-of-12 passing for 55 yards.

The game was scoreless at the half after Knox dodged a bullet early in the game. Lawrence took the opening kickoff and drove right down the field. Butterfield had nine-yard touchdown run called back on a penalty, and Lawrence later faced fourth-and-2 at the Knox three-yard line. Butterfield's pass just missed Trevor Spina at the goal line and Knox took over on downs.

Knox took the opening kickoff of the second half, and Edlund broke

free for a 79-yard run on the second play. He was pushed out of bounds at the Lawrence one-yard line, and Zanger scored on the next play for a 7-0 lead.

The Prairie Fire took over after a punt later in the third quarter at the Lawrence 42. Aided by a personal foul penalty, Knox moved to the Lawrence 12, and Zanger ran it in from there for a 13-0 edge.

Lawrence got on the board with a nice scoring drive early in the fourth quarter. Lawrence looked like it had been stopped when it faced fourth-and-6 at the Knox 34, but Butterfield faked a punt and raced 22 yards to the Knox 12. The Vikings then benefited from a pass interference penalty to get a first down at the two-yard line. Dalton Sendelbach barreled into the end zone on the next play to cut the lead to 13-6.

Knox took the next possession and moved 79 yards in 12 plays, eating up more than seven minutes

in the process, to grab a 20-6 lead. Zander scored a two-yard run with 3:27 left to seal the victory.

Last Week

A powerful ground game and big plays led Lawrence to a 53-7 Midwest Conference rout of Grinnell on Saturday on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Lawrence posted 442 rushing yards with a pair of 100-yard rushers, and the Vikings finished with 622 total yards. The win was No. 500 in Lawrence football history, which dates back to 1893.

Rookie running back Wasonu Allen had eight carries for 146 yards and two touchdowns for Lawrence. Freshman quarterback Philip Santiago ran six times for 140 yards and a touchdown. Santiago also completed 7-of-12 passes for 180 yards and three touchdowns. Donnel Haley added 76 rushing yards on just nine carries for the Vikings.


Jacob Bernholtz had 22 carries for 96 yards to pace Grinnell.

Linebackers Dan Rothbauer and Jake Gostisha spearheaded a Lawrence defense that limited Grinnell to 291 total yards. Rothbauer finished with 19 tackles, including 3.0 tackles for loss. Gostisha had 15 tackles, including 1.0 TFLs, an interception and a pass breakup. Safety Dante Reese collected his second interception on the season and finished with four tackles.

Lawrence got on the board with 6:50 left in the first quarter when Santiago broke through up the middle and went 80 yards for the touchdown. The 80-yard run ties the second-longest run from scrimmage in Lawrence history and gave the Vikings a 6-0 lead.

After Gostisha's interception stopped the next Grinnell drive, Santiago hit Chris Shaw with a 74-yard touchdown pass and Lawrence led 13-0 late in the first quarter.

The Vikings tacked on two more touchdowns in the second quar-

ter as Trevor Spina sprinted in from five yards out and Santiago hit Cam Boerm with a 20-yard scoring pass for a 25-0 lead.

Lawrence led 25-7 at the half but quickly expanded that lead in the third quarter. Santiago found Cole Erickson on a 31-yard touchdown pass on Lawrence's first drive of the quarter. Allen then burst up the middle on a 23-yard touchdown run, and the Vikings led 39-7 after three.

Reese's interception set up the next Lawrence touchdown as the Vikings took over at their own 33-yard line. Freshman Jack Marinich capped a nine-play, 67-yard drive with his first

career touchdown on an eight-yard scoring run early in the fourth quarter for a 46-7 edge.

Allen capped the scoring with a spectacular 54-yard touchdown run midway through the fourth quarter for the final margin.

The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 4-14 (.222). Damon Tomeo (Po-

mona-Pitzer 1999) is in his fourth season at Knox and has a record of 7-31 (.184). He is in his eighth season overall and has a record of 21-61 (.256).

Vikings Update

►It was a historic win for the Vikings last Saturday as Lawrence picked up the victory No.



500 in program history. Lawrence has an overall record of 500-465-29 and joins Monmouth, Cornell and Ripon as the only other schools in league history with 500 victories.

►For the second time this season, Lawrence had two 100-yard rushers in a game. Freshmen Wasonu Allen (Austell, Ga./South Cobb) and Philip Santiago (Boynton Beach, Fla./Boca Raton) both topped the century mark against Grinnell. Allen needed just eight carries to pile up a career-high 146 yards for an average of 18.3 per carry. Santiago carried six times for a career-high 140 for an average of 23.3 yards per attempt. Allen now has 61 carries for 325 yards and four TDs on the season.

►Santiago ripped off an 80-yard touchdown run to start the scoring in the first quarter. That ties the second-longest run in school history with four others.

The last player to do it was Tyler Mazur vs. Monmouth in 2010. The record for a run from scrimmage is 91 yards by Adrell Bullock vs. Knox in 2004. Santiago has 393 rushing yards on 50 carries this season.

►Santiago completed 7-of-12 passes for 180 yards and a career-high three TD passes against Grinnell, which was his first career start. He has completed 53-of-110 passes for 693 yards, five TDs and two interceptions this season.

►Senior Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./Coronado) has a team-best 23 catches for 268 yards and two TDs this season.

►Junior running back Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) finished with nine carries for 76 yards against Grinnell and leads the team with 75 carries for 397 yards this season.

►Freshman Jack Marinich (Alpharetta, Ga./Milton) scored his first career touchdown on an eight-yard run in the fourth quarter against Grinnell. Marinich has two carries and two catches this season.

►Lawrence piled up 442 rushing yards against Grinnell, which fell just 46 yards shy of the school game record of 488, set against St. Norbert in 1995. Lawrence is averaging 222.5 rushing yards per game.

►The Vikings pushed their scoring average on the season to 20.3 points per game, which is ninth in the league. Lawrence is ninth in total offense at 352.3 yards per contest.

►Junior linebacker Dan Rothbauer (Appleton, Wis./North) had a career day against Grinnell with a career-high 19 tackles, which is the second-best game total in the conference this season. Rothbauer, who also had 3.0 TFLs against Grinnell, now has 68 tackles and a team-best 10.5 TFLs this season.

►Linebacker Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) posted his fifth double-digit tackle game of the season against Grinnell. Gostisha piled up a career-high 15 tackles, eclipsing his previous high of 14 set earlier this season against Illinois College. Gostisha has a team-high 85 tackles this season, including 6.5 TFLs. Gostisha also picked off his fifth pass of the season last Saturday and is tied for lead in the conference with five.

►Rookie Terrell Myers Jr. (Marietta, Ga./Marietta) was leading all of NCAA Division III in kickoff returns at 34.7

yards per return, but Grinnell didn't kick the ball deep against the Vikings so Myers had no returns last Saturday and fell out of the rankings. Myers did pick up a pass breakup and leads the team with seven this season.

►Lawrence lowered its points allowed to 25.5 per game with the seven-point effort against Grinnell and that ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings are third in total defense at 353.9 yards per contest.

Scouting Knox

►Lake Forest romped to a 34-3 lead at the half and went on to a 55-17 win over visiting Knox last Saturday. Lake Forest running back Joey Valdivia carried 14 times for 203 yards and six touchdowns.



►Knox has a three-pronged running attack led by quarterback Matt McCaffrey, who has 74 carries for 366 yards and eight touchdowns. Nick Edlund has 92 carries for 320 yards and Braeden Westfall has 76 attempts for 312 yards.

►McCaffrey has completed 159-of-279 passes for 1,719 yards, six touchdowns and nine interceptions.

►Knox is eighth in the league in scoring at 21.8 points per game. The Prairie Fire is eighth in total offense at 368.6 yards per game.

►Defensive back Logan Hollis leads the team with 67 tackles, including 2.0 TFLs. Linebacker Mario Whitley has the team lead with 3.5 sacks and is tied for the team lead with 5.5 TFLs.

►Defensive back Evan Economos leads the team with four interceptions and five pass breakups.

►The Prairie Fire is seventh in scoring defense at 33.8 points per game.
