Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 1-9. Andy Carr (Winona State 1999) is in his sixth

Vikings Update

►The Vikings enter the 2016 season with more new faces than returning ones. The Vikings brought back 23 players and 15 of those were starters in 2015. Lawrence has 28 new faces, 27 freshmen and one transfer.



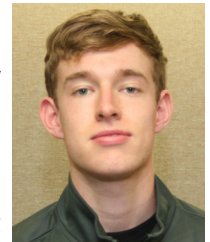
►The Vikings return multiple skill players on both offense and defense. On the offensive side, sophomore quarterback Ryan Butterfield (McDonough, Ga./Strong Rock Christian) is back after completing 51.8 percent of his passes for 967 yards, nine touchdowns and just four inter-

ceptions as a rookie. He also averaged 5.5 yards per carry and posted a 243-yard rushing game in the season finale. That's the best rushing total by a quarterback in Lawrence history. Butterfield led the team in rushing last season with 454 yards.

►The top targets in receivers Jacob Berman (Bethesda, Md./Wallace) and Cole Erickson (Appleton, Wis./North) are also back. Berman caught 31 passes for 315 yards and a score, and Erickson hauled in 17 passes for 242 yards. Erickson also is likely to handle the punting duties. Lawrence also gets a boost from the return of senior receiver Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./

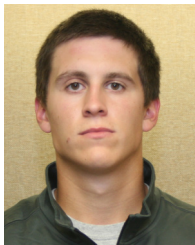
►The big change in the Lawrence offense will come up front where the Vikings have replaced four starters. The lone starter back from last season is

tackle and All-Midwest Conference selection Jackson Straughn (Heber City, Utah/Wasatch). Straughn will likely be joined by four freshmen in the starting lineup on Saturday.

►The defense also returns its core of playmakers from a season ago, led by all-conference selections Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) and Jacob Lueck (Glen Ellyn, Ill./Glenbard East). Gostisha, playing his first season of defense in 2015 after serving as a backup quarterback as a rookie, piled up 88 tackles, including a team-best 10.5 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks. Lueck led the squad with 92 tackles and picked up 4.5 TFLs and 2.0 sacks.

►The Vikings also have all-conference return man and defensive back Alic Riedel (Appleton, Wis./East) back. Riedel averaged 21.3 yards per kickoff return and that included a touchdown in the 2015 season opener. He also picked up 4.7 yards per punt return. As a defender, Riedel tied for the team lead with two intercep-

►It looks like senior Pat O'Mahoney (Evanston, Ill./Evanston Township) gets the nod on the kicking duties in the season opener. The Vikings have three kickers on the roster, including rookie William Nichols (Aldie, Va./John Champe), who is the cousin of Green Bay Packers kicker Mason Crosby. Nichols will get plenty of work at re-

ceiver for the Vikings as well.

►Lawrence, which has been playing football since 1893, is looking to improve on its 54-67-1 record in season openers. Lawrence's last win in a season opener was a 21-8 victory at Minnesota-Morris in a downpour.

►While this is the first meeting between Lawrence and Presentation, it also appears to be the first time the

Vikings will play in South Dakota. The longest road trip in Lawrence football history came in 1998 when the Vikings traveled to Pomona-Pitzer in California. Prior to that, Lawrence's longest trip came in 1984 when the Vikings traveled to San Antonio, Texas, to face Trinity.

►Facing an opponent from the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) is also unusual for the Vikings. This is Lawrence's first game against an NAIA opponent since the Vikings played the College of St. Francis back in 1987.

Saints Update

►The Saints are members of the North Star Athletic Conference, which is made up of nine schools but just seven for football. The nine schools are strung out over five states (Wisconsin, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota and Nebraska).

►Presentation, which is located in Aberdeen, S.D., is entering its sixth



season of football, all under the direction of head coach Andy Carr. The Saints went 4-6 a season ago, picking up two wins against Trinity Bible and one win apiece against Briar Cliff and Finlandia.

►The Saints' offense is triggered by sophomore quarterback Austin Eggle, who completed 170 of 316 passes for 2,260 yards, 23 touchdowns and 10 interceptions.

►The Saints lost 1,000-yard rusher Hayden Zenner, and the top returning runner is Edmonds Jacobs, who averaged 7.0 yards per carry in limited action in 2015.

►The top receivers back for Presentation are Logan Weisser and William Moffet. Weisser grabbed 32 passes for 562 yards and three TDs, and Moffet had 12 catches for 207 yards and two scores.

►Defensive end Jeff Branch is coming off a big season in 2015. The senior piled up 50 tackles and had 11.0 TFLs and 4.0 sacks a season ago. Junior

linebacker Skyler Miller also returns after picking up 49 tackles, including 6.0 TFLs and 1.0 sacks a season ago.

Extra Points

►This is a “bridge” year for the Midwest Conference as it awaits a 12th league member for football. The league was split into North and South divisions for the 2014 and 2015 seasons, but the departure of Carroll for the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin forced a change for this season. The schools will play an eight-game league schedule against all of their former divisional foes, and the remainder of the schedule will be made up of teams from the rest of the league. This remains in effect for all of one season as the conference goes back to a 12-team league for 2017 when the University of Chicago joins for football. The teams will again be split into divisions, and Lawrence’s fellow North Division members will be Chicago, Beloit, Macalester, Ripon and St. Norbert. The South Division will be Lake Forest, Knox, Monmouth, Illinois College, Grinnell and Cornell.
