**The Series**

In a series that stretches all the way back to 1902, Lawrence holds a 27-22 advantage over the Foresters. The teams played regularly from the early part of the 20th century until 1935. The teams didn't play from 1936 through 1973, and the series started again in 1974 when the Foresters joined the Midwest Conference. Lake Forest has won the last seven meetings, and Lawrence's biggest win in the rivalry, a 52-20 triumph, came in 2005.

**Last Meeting**

Lake Forest blocked two fields in the final three minutes, including one on the last play of the game, to hang on for a 14-13 Midwest Conference win over Lawrence on Sept. 14, 2013, in the Banta Bowl.

The Foresters also blocked an extra point that proved to be the winning margin.

Lawrence trailed by a point when it took over at its own 36-yard line with 9:51 left. The Vikings took 13 plays to move all the way to the Lake Forest two-yard line before being stopped. Freshman Patrick O'Mahoney lined up for a 19-yard field goal, and the kick was blocked. The ball went out of the end zone and Lake Forest took over at its own 20 with 2:41 left.

Lawrence was out of timeouts, but the Foresters failed to pick up a first down. Lake Forest did the Vikings a favor by throwing an incomplete pass on third down to stop the clock. Lake Forest punted, and Lawrence got the ball back at its own 23 with 47 seconds left.

Lawrence quarterback Luke Barthelmess hit Sam Wagner with a 32-yard completion on the first play to move the ball to the Lake Forest 45. Barthelmess then ripped off runs

of 11 and 24 yards to move to the Lake Forest 10-yard line.

After a pair of incompletions, the Vikings were called for offensive pass interference with six seconds left. O'Mahoney lined up for a 42-yard field goal, but the kick was blocked again as time expired.

Barthelmess ran 21 times for 124 yards, and he completed 24 of 36 passes for 284 yards and a touchdown. Taylor Mandich grabbed seven passes for 95 yards for the Vikings.

The Lawrence offense piled up 450 yards of offense, including 166 on the ground. The Lawrence defense limited Lake Forest to just 239 yards, and the Foresters were just 3-for-11 on third down.

**Last Week**

St. Norbert scored 35 second-quarter points Saturday to break open a close game and went on to a 62-0 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Ron Roberts Field at the

Banta Bowl.

The game turned early in the second quarter with St. Norbert holding a 6-0 lead. Lawrence had driven from its 25-yard line all the way to the St. Norbert 29, but Ryan Butterfield's pass on fourth-and-three fell incomplete.

J.T. Crosby hit Samuel Staehling on a 71-yard scoring pass on the next play, and St. Norbert led 13-0. After St. Norbert got another one-play drive on Elijah Fort's 41-yard touchdown run for a 20-0 lead, the Vikings fumbled the ensuing kickoff.

St. Norbert took over at the Lawrence four, and Fort scored two plays later for a 27-0 edge. Crosby added two more short scoring runs, one set up by a fumbled punt, and the Green Knights led 41-0 at the half.

The Vikings put together two nice drives in the second half, moving to the St. Norbert six on one and the Green Knights' 17 on the other, but came up with no points.

Quarterback Philip Santiago ran nine times for 56 yards and was 6-of-12 passing for 49 yards for the Vikings. Butterfield, who started the game at quarterback, had 13 carries for 47 yards and was 2-of-11 passing for four yards.

Crosby ran 13 times for 83 yards and three touchdowns for St. Norbert and completed 12-of-19 passes for 199 yards. Fort ran 11 times for 80 yards and three touchdowns. Staehling had two catches for 104 yards.

Linebacker Hunter Adams finished with a game-high 11 tackles for Lawrence. Linebacker Jake Gostisha finished with nine stops and picked off his fourth pass of the season.

### The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 3-13 (.188).

### Vikings Update

►The Vikings are going for program victory No. 500 on Saturday. Lawrence's win over Beloit was 499 in 123 seasons of Lawrence football. Among Midwest Conference teams, only three are in the 500-win club. Monmouth has 552 victories, Ripon has 545 and Cornell has 511. Lawrence has an overall record of 499-464-29. The Vikings have played



at least three games every fall since 1893, with the exception of the 1917 when no games were played due to World War I.

►Lawrence continues to split the quarterback duties between sophomore Ryan Butterfield (McDonough, Ga./Strong Rock Christian) and freshman Philip Santiago (Boynton Beach, Fla./Boca Raton). Butterfield started and was 2-for-11 passing for just four yards. He also ran 13 times for 47 yards. Santiago was 6-for-12 passing for 49 yards and ran nine times for 56 yards. Their passing totals on the season are nearly identical as Santiago is com-

pleting 45.9 percent of his passes and Butterfield is at 45.7. Santiago is averaging 6.6 yards per carry, and Butterfield is at 5.1.

►Lawrence did manage 147 yards on the ground against St. Norbert, and Butterfield and running back Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) are the team's leading rushers. Butterfield has 51 carries for 260, and Haley has 54 carries for 251, an average of 4.6 per carry.

►Senior Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./Coronado) was held without a catch against St. Norbert but continues to lead the team with 18 catches for 212 yards and a touchdown.

►Lawrence ranks 10th in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense at 13.7 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in total offense at 294.2 yards per game.

►Linebacker Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) posted nine tackles against St. Norbert and remains on track to top 100 tackles for the season. Gostisha has 62 tackles and ranks third in the Midwest Conference at 10.3 tackles per game. Gostisha, who has 5.5 TFLs, also is tied for the team lead with four interceptions after getting a pick against St. Norbert. Should Gostisha get to the 100-tackle plateau, he would be the first Lawrence player to do that since Jacques Hacquebord (112) and Scott Caroen (104) both did it in 2003.

►Defensive end Cullen Ellis (New York, N.Y./Beacon) has been doing a lot of work on the other side of the line of scrimmage. He has a team-high

8.0 TFLs and paces the squad with 3.0 sacks. Ellis has 22 tackles on the season.

►Rookie Terrell Myers Jr. (Marietta, Ga./Marietta) picked up a pair of pass breakups against St. Norbert and leads the team with five on the season.

►Lawrence ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference in total defense at 358.2 yards per game. The Vikings are fifth in scoring defense at 27.2 points per contest.

### Scouting Lake Forest

►Lake Forest scored 14 fourth-quarter points to pull away for a 35-14 Midwest Conference victory at Macalester last Saturday. The Scots had closed to 21-14 midway through the third quarter, but the Foresters scored twice in a span of 38 seconds late in the game. Lake Forest's Joey Valdivia ripped off a 74-yard scoring run, and Macalester threw an interception two plays later. Valdivia



broke free for a 44-yard touchdown run in the next play to seal the victory for the Foresters.

►Running back Joey Valdivia had a huge game against Macalester as he ran 30 times for 278 yards and four touchdowns. Valdivia has already topped 1,000 yards on the season and leads the Midwest Conference in rushing at 153.1 yards per game. He has 155 carries for 1,072 yards on the campaign.

►Sophomore quarterback Jagan Cleary has triggered the Lake Forest attack this season. He has completed 139-of-213 passes for 1,611 yards. Cleary ranks second in the Midwest Conference at 230.1 yards passing per game. He has tossed 12 touchdowns and five interceptions.

►The top receivers for the Foresters are seniors Alex Pasiewicz and Charlie Quinn. Pasiewicz has 38 catches for 531 yards and seven touchdowns. Quinn has 35 catches for 311 yards and a pair of scores.

►Lake Forest ranks fourth in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 34.9 points per game. The Foresters are fifth in total offense at 422.6 yards per game.

►Lake Forest's defense is allowing 26.3 points per game, which is good for fifth in the conference. The Foresters are seventh in total defense at 399.9 yards per game.

►The Lake Forest defense is paced by junior R.J. Pompey and freshman John Laponte. Pompey has a team-high 43 tackles, and Laponte is second on the squad at 42.

►Junior linebacker Pat McDonough is tops on the squad at 6.5 TFLs, and Jordan McInerney and McDonough both have 2.0 sacks.

►The Foresters have picked off six passes, including a team-high two by junior defensive back Chase Stagboom.
