The Series

Carroll holds a 32-26-4 lead over Lawrence in a series that dates back to 1908. The Pioneers have won the last six meetings, and Lawrence's last victory was a 27-14 win back in 2007.

Last Meeting

Carroll pulled out to a big early lead and went on to a 48-14 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Oct. 12, 2013, at Schneider Stadium.

Carroll led 13-0 after the first quarter and scored four second-quarter touchdowns to race to a 41-0 lead at the half.

Running back Lamont Williams powered the Carroll offense by running 19 times for 216 yards and four touchdowns. Williams, who had touchdown runs of 10, one, 83 and 12 yards, averaged 11.4 yards per carry.

The Pioneers threw only nine passes in the game as they ran for 314 yards as a team.

Lawrence was limited to only 235 yards against a stout Carroll defense. Quarterback Luke Barthelmess was 8 of 16 passing for 81 yards and a touchdown. Halfback Dalton Sendelbach ran 24 times for 94 yards to lead Lawrence's ground game.

After Williams put the Pioneers up 27-0 with his 83-yard touchdown run in the late in the second quarter, Ty Zimmerman blocked a punt and returned it 20 yards for a touchdown. Williams then added another touchdown run to put the Pioneers in command at the break.

Lawrence got on the board with cornerback Zach Eichhorst's first career touchdown. The sophomore picked off Tyler Schovanec's pass and returned it 41 yards for a touchdown to cut the lead to 48-7. Lawrence added its final touchdown midway through the fourth quarter when Barthelmess capped a 14-play, 68-yard drive with a 13-yard scoring pass to Dan Dubnicka. Dubnicka finished with three catches for 35 yards.

Last Week

Chance Byrd tossed three touchdown passes Saturday and Taylor Mandich had a career day as Lawrence topped Beloit 21-13 in a Midwest Conference North Division game at the Banta Bowl.

Byrd, a freshman quarterback making his first start, was 23-for-36 for 274 yards and three touchdowns. Mandich, a senior receiver from Green Bay, had a career-high eight catches for 130 yards and a touchdown for the Vikings.

The Lawrence defense limited Beloit to 266 yards and made a key stop late in the game to preserve the victory. Linebacker Brandon Taylor paced

the Lawrence defense with 14 tackles and two pass breakups.

Beloit was down by eight but got an interception on a tipped ball and took over at the Beloit 35-yard line with 5:30 left. After three consecutive runs by Mason Dixon, who had 31 carries for 132 yards, the Bucs were facing fourth-and-four. Evan Phillips' fourth-down pass was deflected away from receiver Michael Nolden by Taylor to give the ball back to Lawrence.

The Vikings then picked up a pair of first downs to run out the clock.

Beloit led 3-0 in the opening guarter, but Lawrence took the ensuing possession and moved 75 yards in 12 plays for the game's first touchdown. Byrd hit freshman receiver and Appleton native Cole Erickson with an eightyard touchdown pass to complete the drive and give Lawrence a 7-3 lead.

The Vikings then put together another long scoring drive early in the second quarter. Lawrence went 80 yards in eight plays and Byrd found Trevor Spina with a 24-yard touchdown pass for a 14-3 Lawrence lead with 11:53 left in the first half.

Beloit kicker Kam Sallee connected on a 36-yard field goal midway through the third quarter to cut the lead 14-6.

Sallee then missed a 27-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter, and Lawrence hit on a big play on the next drive. Mandich caught a 55-yard touchdown pass from Byrd, and Lawrence led 21-6 with 8:43 left in the game.

The Bucs marched right back down the field and Phillips found Sallee on a 12-yard scoring pass on fourth down to cut the margin to 21-13 with 6:45 remaining.

The Coaches

Chris Har-(Cumberlands ris 2000) is serving as Lawrence's interim head coach. Mark Krzykowski (Carroll 1994) is in his fourth season at Carroll and Chris Harris

Vikings Update

The 21-13 victory over Beloit came in Lawrence's homecoming game (the administra-



tion at LU calls it Fall Festival). It was Lawrence's first homecoming victory since a 17-13 win over Knox College in 2009.

▶ Freshman quarterback Chance Byrd Ala./Lin-(Lincoln, coln) was successful in his debut as the starter with the win over Beloit. The last Lawrence quarter- Chance Byrd back to win his first

start was Luke Barthelmess, who was at the controls when the Vikings beat Knox 33-12 on Sept. 11, 2010. Byrd was 23-of-36 passing for 274 yards, three touchdowns and one interception. On the season, Byrd is 57-of-110 for 763 yards, seven touchdowns and eight interceptions.

► Senior receiver Taylor Mandich (Green Bay, Wis./ Southwest) had a monster game in the victory over Beloit. grabbed Mandich a career-high eight Taylor Mandich catches for 130 yards



and caught the game-winning touchdown pass. Mandich now ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference with 84.6 receiving yards per game. He is sixth in the league at 4.6 catches per game. Mandich's totals are 23 catches for 423 yards and four touchdowns. He leads Lawrence in all three categories.

► The Vikings did a great job of closing out Saturday's win over Beloit. Lawrence got the ball back with 3:38 remaining, but Beloit had a pair of timeouts left so Lawrence needed a first down. Facing third-and-five at the Beloit 36, Byrd completed a clutch pass to Mandich for 14 yards and a first down. Byrd and Dalton Sendelbach (Evansville, Wis./Evansville) then ripped off runs of nine and seven yards, respectively, to seal the win.

Byrd completed a pass to six different receivers in the victory.

Lawrence's freshmen receivers continue to contribute on a weekly basis. Appleton natives Dan Rothbauer (Appleton, Wis./North) and Cole Erickson (Appleton, Wis./North) have combined for 22 catches for 244 yards and three touchdowns.

► The Vikings played without starting left tackle Spencer Swick (Kimberly, Wis./Kimberly) for the second consecutive week. Sophomore Jackson

Lawrence ranks sixth in the conference in scoring offense at 21.4 points per contest. The Vikings are seventh in total offense at 324.0 yards per game.

► Senior linebacker Brandon Taylor (Johnsbura, III./Johnsburg) had a big game against Beloit and made a key play near the end of the

game. Taylor had a Brandon Taylor season-high 14 tack-

les and picked up two pass breakups. He broke up a fourth-down pass late in the game, and that play gave the ball back to Lawrence, which then ran out the clock. Taylor ranks seventh in the Midwest Conference at 9.2 tackles per game.

Sophomore defensive end Tony Harth (Madison, Wis./West) is starting to compile some solid numbers. In his first year as a starter, Harth is third on the team with 35 tackles and he leads

the team in both tackles for loss (7.5) and sacks (3.0). Harth is sixth in the conference in TFLs and is 13th in sacks.



► Beloit seemed to Tony Harth go away from rook-

ie cornerback Alic Riedel (Appleton, Wis./East), but sophomore cornerback Nick Ulloa (Burlington, Wis./Catholic Central) responded by coming up with a pair of pass breakups and five tackles.

A tip of the cap to defensive coordinator Jeff Jansen, who is in his ninth year as an assistant coach for the Vikings. Lawrence has moved up to fifth in the conference in scoring defense at 24.2 points per game. The Vikings are fifth in total defense at 331.4 yards per contest.

Pioneers Update

Carroll put together an impressive performance in a 30-6 victory



over St. Norbert last Saturday. Quarterback Kyle Burlingame led the Carroll offense as he threw for two touchdowns and ran for two more. Burlingame was 20-of-28 passing for 286 yards. He also ran for 54 yards. The Carroll defense came up big and limited St. Norbert to just 185 yards of offense.

► Carroll is off to its first 5-0 start since the 1992 season.

Quarterback Kyle Burlingame was named the Midwest Conference Offensive Player of the Week in the wake of the Pioneers' victory. Burlingame is one of the league's top passers and has completed 68-of-109 passes for 901 yards, eight touchdowns and three interceptions.

The Carroll offense is powered by the legs of running back Lamont Williams. He ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference in rushing at 94.6 yards per game. Williams, who is averaging 4.6 yards per carry, has 102 carries for 473 yards and nine touchdowns.

The top receiver for the Pioneers is Kevin Jennings. He is in the top five in the conference in both catches and receiving yards per game. Jennings has 25 catches for 436 yards and five touchdowns. He's averaging a healthy 17.4 yards per catch.

► The Pioneers rank third in the conference in scoring offense at 31.4 points per game. Carroll is fourth in total offense at 378.6 yards per contest.

Defensive back Ryan Klapper was named the Midwest Conference Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against St. Norbert. Klapper picked up seven tackles, intercepted a pass and forced a fumble against the Green Knights.

Carroll is first in total defense and scoring defense in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers are allowing

September 6 Rockford 34, Lawrence 6

ROCKFORD, III. — The Lawrence University football team dug itself a big hole early, and



Rockford University pulled away late for a 34-6 nonconference victory at Sam Greeley Field.

The Regents (1-0) surged to a 19-0 lead just 11 minutes into the game, and Rockford then put up a pair of touchdowns in a 16-second span in the fourth quarter to seal the win.

Quarterback Andrew Stochl and receiver Milton Phillips did most of the damage for the Regents. Stochl completed 17-of-27 passes for 291 yards and three touchdowns. Phillips caught five passes for 127 yards and a score.

Lawrence (0-1) struggled on offense and had just 234 total yards. Rockford rolled up 448 yards of offense.

After two touchdown passes from Stochl and a scoring run from Pete Berry put the Regents up early, Lawrence cut the deficit to 19-6. Freshman Alic Riedel blocked Cody Casazza's punt to give Lawrence the ball at the Rockford 21-yard line. Lawrence scored eight plays later on Tanner Schuh's two-yard run.

Lawrence was driving again in the final minutes of the first half, but Schuh was intercepted in the Rockford end zone to end the threat.

The score remained the same until Rockford drove 73 yards in eight plays midway through the fourth quarter. Stochl hit Dane Kirk with a 22yard scoring pass for a 27-6 lead with 8:59 left.

On the next play from scrimmage, Pascal Sylla intercepted Lawrence backup quarterback Chance Byrd and returned it 31 yards for a touchdown and a 34-6 lead.

Schuh finished 10-of-29 passing for 103 yards. Byrd was 6-for-16 passing for 68 yards and two interceptions. Byrd led the team with seven carries for 34 yards, and Dan Rothbauer, Taylor Mandich and Tyler Lueck all had four catches apiece for the Vikings.

September 13 Lawrence 59, Maranatha Baptist 0

A P P L E T O N , Wis. — The Lawrence University football team routed Maranatha Bap-



tist University 59-0 in a nonconference game at the Banta Bowl.

Lawrence quarterback Tanner Schuh played only the first half but ran for 99 yards and a touchdown and threw for 244 and two touchdowns as the Vikings (1-1) bolted a 28-0 lead at the half. Backup quarterback Chance Byrd completed 11 of 15 passes for 152 yards and two touchdowns and ran 11 times for 46 yards and a score.

Taylor Mandich grabbed seven passes for 181 yards and three touchdowns, including a 70-yard scoring pass in the first half. Dalton Sendelbach added 14 carries for 89 yards and a touchdown for the Vikings. Lawrence kicker Patrick O'Mahoney also tied the school record of Cody Robel and Kraig Krueger with eight extra points.

The Lawrence defense, which held Maranatha to just 76 yards, recorded its first shutout since beating Ripon College 26-0 in 1991. It was a team effort on defense with Tony Harth leading the way with six tackles, including a sack and 2.5 tackles for loss. Lawrence limited Maranatha (0-2) to 20 carries for a minus-32 yards on the ground.

The Vikings also intercepted five passes, one each by Alic Riedel, Dan Taylor, Nick Ulloa, Jake Walker and defensive end Gabor Bukszar.

Lawrence scored touchdowns on its first three possessions and four of its first five. Trevor Spina had a fouryard run for the first touchdown, and Schuh scored from three yards out on the next drive for a 14-0 lead. After Mandich had his 55-yard touchdown catch called back due to a penalty, he hooked up with Schuh on a 70-yard scoring pass on the next play for a 21-0 lead. Mandich then caught a 23-yard scoring pass with 4:51 left in the second quarter to put the Vikings up 28-0.

Lawrence got a 21-yard field goal from O'Mahoney to make it 31-0 midway through the third quarter. The Vikings then picked up touchdowns on four of their next five possessions to complete the scoring. Byrd connected with Cole Erickson on an 11yard touchdown pass and then hit Mandich from 21 yards out to push the lead to 45-0 after three quarters. Byrd had a 19-yard scoring run in the fourth quarter, and Sendelbach finished the scoring with a 20-yard touchdown scamper.

The big bright spot for the Sabercats was linebacker Ethan Kennon, who recorded 21 tackles, including 15 solo.

Septmber 27 Knox 45, Lawrence 14

GALESBURG, III. — The Knox College football team pulled out to a 35-0 lead at the half and



went on to a 45-14 nonconference win over Lawrence University at the Knosher Bowl.

Knox (2-1) got two first-half touchdowns from Terry White and two more first-half scores from Matt McCaffrey to pull away. The Prairie Fire posted 502 yards of offense, including 345 on the ground.

Quarterback Chance Byrd ran for one touchdown and threw for another to pace Lawrence (1-2), which was limited to 226 yards of offense. Byrd had 11 carries for 50 yards and completed 8-of-16 passes for 127 yards, one touchdown and one interception.

Trevor Spina had the biggest receiving day of his career with six catches for 109 yards and a touch-

Saturday against Grinnell College, and the Pioneers went on to a 29-7 nonconference victory at the Banta Bowl.

Grinnell (1-3) limited Lawrence (1-3) to 181 yards of total offense, including 45 in the first half.

Sam Poulos tossed a pair of touchdown passes for the Pioneers, and Jacob Bernholtz ran 22 times for 102 yards and a touchdown. Lawrence quarterback Chance Byrd, who was forced into action after starter Tanner Schuh was hurt on the game's first drive, was 9-for-27 for 142 yards and a touchdown, but he threw four interceptions.

Grinnell got on the board late in the first quarter when the Pioneers moved 59 yards in 10 plays for the game's first touchdown. Jacob Meixler caught a 16-yard scoring pass from Poulos for a 7-0 lead. Meixler finished with six catches for 78 yards and two scores.

Linebacker David Ternes made 9-0 Grinnell when he tackled Bryd in the end zone with just 45 seconds left in the first quarter.

Lawrence 21, Beloit 13

A P P L E T O N, Wis. — Chance Byrd tossed three touchdown passes and Taylor Man-



dich had a career day as the Lawrence University football team topped Beloit College 21-13 in a Midwest Conference North Division game at the Banta Bowl.

Byrd, a freshman quarterback making his first start, was 23-for-36 for 274 yards and three touchdowns. Mandich, a senior receiver from Green Bay, had a career-high eight catches for 130 yards and a touchdown for the Vikings (2-3, 1-0 MWC North).

The Lawrence defense limited Beloit (2-3, 0-1) to 266 yards and made a key stop late in the game to preserve the victory. Linebacker Brandon Taylor paced the Lawrence defense with 14 tackles and two pass breakups.

Beloit was down by eight but got an interception on a tipped ball and took over at the Beloit 35-yard line with 5:30 left. After three consecutive runs by Mason Dixon, who had 31 carries for 132 yards, the Bucs were facing fourth-and-four. Evan Phillips' fourth-down pass was deflected away from receiver Michael Nolden by Taylor to give the ball back to Lawrence.

The Vikings then picked up a pair of first downs to run out the clock.

Beloit led 3-0 in the opening quarter, but Lawrence took the ensuing possession and moved 75 yards in 12 plays for the game's first touchdown. Byrd hit freshman receiver and Appleton native Cole Erickson with an eight-yard touchdown pass to complete the drive and give Lawrence a 7-3 lead.

The Vikings then put together another long scoring drive early in the second quarter. Lawrence went 80 yards in eight plays and Byrd found Trevor Spina with a 24-yard touchdown pass for a 14-3 Lawrence lead with 11:53 left in the first half.

Beloit kicker Kam Sallee connected on a 36-yard field goal midway through the third quarter to cut the lead 14-6.

Sallee then missed a 27-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter, and Lawrence hit on a big play on the next drive. Mandich caught a 55-yard touchdown pass from Byrd, and Lawrence led 21-6 with 8:43 left in the game.

The Bucs marched right back down the field and Phillips found Sallee on a 12-yard scoring pass on fourth down to cut the margin to 21-13 with 6:45 remaining.

This was Lawrence's homecoming game, and marked the Vikings first victory at homecoming since a 17-13 win over Knox College in 2009.
