### The Series

Illinois College holds a 15-5 lead in a series that started in 1986. The Blueboys have won six straight, and Lawrence's last victory was a 22-18 victory in 2007.

### Last Meeting

Cecil Brimmage ran for 273 yards, and Illinois College battled to a 26-6 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Oct. 5, 2013, at the Banta Bowl.

Brimmage carried 29 times and scored a third-quarter touchdown. Blueboys quarterback Michael Bates completed 14 of 25 passes for 195 yards and two touchdowns.

Lawrence quarterback Luke Barthelmess went 22 of 40 for 230

yards, one touchdown and two interceptions. Barthelmess also posted his third 100-yard rushing game of the season with 24 carries for 117 yards.

Illinois College jumped out to a 13-0 lead in the first quarter with a Bates touchdown pass and a Kurt Frischman interception return for a touchdown. Frischman, a defensive lineman, batted a Barthelmess pass and hauled it in. He rumbled 75 yards for the score.

Lawrence cut the lead to 13-6 on a long scoring drive early in the second quarter. The Vikings moved 88 yards in 13 plays and took more than seven minutes off the clock. Barthelmess hit Sam Wagner with a nine-yard touchdown pass with 11:54 left in the first half.

With Brimmage doing nearly all the damage, Illinois College scored early in the second half. Brimmage's 24-yard touchdown run put the Blueboys up 19-6.

After the Blueboys stopped

Lawrence on downs deep in Illinois College territory, they drove back down the field for the final score of the game. Bates hit Kevin Fuller with his second touchdown catch of the game for a 26-6 lead.

Linebacker Andy Paider had a big day for the Lawrence defense with 14 tackles, including 7.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks. Paider also forced a fumble.

### Last Week

Lawrence dominated the second half and rallied for a 14-5 nonconference victory over Finlandia on Sept. 10 on Ron Roberts Field at the Banta Bowl.

Lawrence picked up 200 yards of offense and limited Finlandia to just 43 yards total in the final 30 minutes. The Vikings trailed by two at the half but controlled the ball in the second half as Finlandia had trouble mounting any offense.

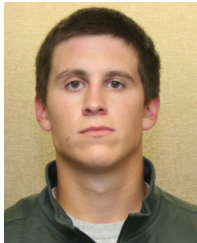
Philip Santiago scored his first collegiate touchdown to put the Vikings ahead in the third quarter, and Pat O'Mahoney added his second field goal of the day in the fourth quarter for the final margin.

Santiago, who played just the second half, completed 7-of-15 passes for 82 yards and ran four times for 36 yards. Donnel Haley led the Lawrence rushing attack with 14 carries for 61 yards, and rookie Zavieh Harrell sparked the offense with seven carries for 45 yards, all but one coming in the second half.

Trevor Spina caught five passes for 58 yards to lead the Vikings' receivers.

Cameron Copeland paced Finlandia with 21 carries for 76 yards. Quarterback Eddie Yearby was 10-for-22 for 60 yards and threw three interceptions.

Linebacker Jake Gostisha made two interceptions, both coming on spectacular diving plays, for the Vikings and finished with seven tackles, 1.0 tackles for loss and a pass breakup. Jake Lueck added seven tackles for the Vikings before leaving the game with an injury.

Finlandia led 5-0 thanks to a Lawrence fumble that was covered up by the Vikings in the end zone for a safety and a 23-yard field goal.

Haley's 39-yard run set up O'Mahoney for a 34-yard field goal to trim the margin to 5-3 early in the second quarter.

The Vikings then put together a seven-play, 59-yard drive for the game's only touchdown late in the third quarter. Santiago completed passes of 21 yards to Spina and 15 yards to Cole Erickson to set the Vikings up at the Finlandia 16-yard line. Santiago ran in untouched on the next play for the touchdown, and Wes Hetcher passed to Erickson for the two-point conversion for an 11-5

Lawrence got the ball back to start the fourth quarter and moved 65 yards in 10 plays to the Finlandia two. The big play on the drive was Harrell's 34-yard run to the Finlandia 15. The Vikings had to settle for O'Mahoney's 19-yard field goal and a 14-5 edge.

Yearby threw an interception, completed on a diving catch from

Dante Reese, on the next play from scrimmage. Finlandia's defense held, but the Lions couldn't move the ball on their final two possessions. Lawrence limited the Lions to just eight yards the last two times they had the ball to close out the win.

For the second straight week, the Vikings held an opponent to less than 200 yards of offense as the Lions fin-

ished with 173. Lawrence, which held Finlandia to 1-of-12 on third down, had 282 yards of offense.

### The Coaches

Rob McCarthy (Concordia Moorhead 1989) is in his second season as Lawrence's head coach and has a record of 2-10 (.167). Ray DeFrisco (North Park 2002) is in his first season at Illinois College and has a record of 1-2 (.333).

### Vikings Update

►The Vikings are kicking off earlier than they have in nearly 125 years of football. It is believed that the



11:30 a.m. kickoff time against Illinois College is the earliest ever. The earliest previous kickoff was noon for the 1981 NCAA Division III playoff game against Minnesota-Morris.

►The Lawrence defense has put together two very good performances in the opening two weeks. Lawrence gave up just 38 yards rushing against Presentation in the opener and then allowed only 60 yards passing vs. Finlandia in week two. The Vikings have held both opponents to less than 175 yards of total offense this season and allowed only 43 yards in the second half against Finlandia.

►Lawrence ranks first in the Midwest Conference in total defense at 173.5 yards per game. The Vikings are second in scoring defense at 11.0 points per contest.

►The Vikings rank first in rushing defense at 75.5 yards per game and are allowing 3.1 yards per carry. Lawrence is second in passing defense at 98.0 yards per game, and the Vikings are allowing a league-low 3.8 yards per

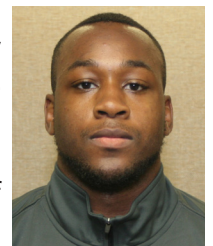

►Junior linebacker Jake Gostisha (Appleton, Wis./East) is among the top 10 in the Midwest Conference in numerous categories. Gostisha ranks 10th in the league at 8.5 tackles per game. He's second at 2.0 TFLs per game and fifth at 1.5 passes defended per contest. Gostisha is tied for tops in the conference with two interceptions, both made in the win over Finlandia.

►Lawrence ranks 11th in the league in scoring offense at a modest 12.0 points per game. The Vikings are 11th in total offense at 258.5 yards per game.

►Sophomore Ryan Butterfield (McDonough, Ga./Strong Rock Christian) and rookie Philip Santiago (Boynton Beach, Fla./Boca Raton) have split playing time at quarterback. Butterfield remains the starter and has completed 14-of-30 passes for 129 yards and one touchdown. Butterfield also has 14 carries for 35 yards. Santiago is 7-of-16 for 82 yards, and he has nine carries for 56 yards and a touchdown.

►Junior Donnel Haley (Chicago, Ill./Loyola) leads the team in rushing with 23 carries for 101 yards, an average of 4.4 yards per carry. He ranks 13th in the league at 50.5 yards per game.

►Senior Trevor Spina (Henderson, Nev./Coronado) is the top receiver on the squad with nine catches for 99 yards, an average of 11.0 yards per catch.

### Scouting Illinois College

►The Blueboys are coming off a 45-35 loss to visiting Macalester this past Saturday. The Scots jumped out to a 22-0 lead midway through the second quarter before the Blueboys rallied. Illinois College tied the game at 35-35 early in the fourth quarter, but Macalester scored 10 points in a stretch of 2:30 in the fourth quarter for the final margin.



►Illinois College ranks sixth in the league in scoring at 24.0 points per game. The Blueboys are fifth in total offense at 415.0 yards per contest.

►Quarterback Blake Matson triggers the Illinois College attack and is 50-for-78 passing (64 percent) for 593 yards and five touchdowns. Matson also has 26 carries for 33 yards.

►The top receiver for the Blueboys is Logan Uyetake, who has 14 catches for 212 yards and a score. Austin Ellsworth has a team-best three touchdown catches among his 11 receptions.

►The Blueboys have multiple backs with at least 17 carries. The top rusher is Daniel Modelski, who has 29 carries for 134 yards. He's averaging 4.6 yards per carry.

►The Blueboys are seventh in the conference in scoring defense at 27.7 points per game. Illinois College is allowing 395.0 yards per game, which ranks seventh in the conference.

►Matt Graef is the top tackler on the squad with 31 stops, which includes 3.5 TFLs and 1.5 sacks. Dyllan Bailey has a team-best 2.0 sacks.

►Austin Ellsworth also is playing defense and has a team-high two interceptions. Steve Reyna leads the club with three pass breakups.
