**THE SERIES**

►UW-Eau Claire holds a 5-1-0 lead in the series, which was first played in the 2000-01 season. Lawrence's lone victory in the series was a 3-2 triumph in the 2009-10 season.

**LAST SERIES**

Lawrence was swept in a NCHA series with No. 1-ranked St. Norbert last weekend.

The Green Knights got a pair of third-period goals on Friday at the Cornerstone Community Center to pull away from Lawrence for a 3-1 victory.

Lawrence goaltender Mattias Soderqvist kept the Vikings in it by stopping a career-high 54 shots. St. Norbert's All-America goaltender David Jacobson was forced to make just

16 saves to pick up the win.

After a scoreless first period, the Green Knights got on the board when Tyler Zepeda scored 5:11 into the second period.

The score remained that way until Erik Cooper scored on a two-man advantage on the power play just 59 seconds into the third period to put the Green Knights up 2-0.

Michael Hill gave St. Norbert a 3-0 lead with 3:29 left, but Lawrence did manage deny the shutout when Ryan Rumble scored with 1:01 remaining.

The Green Knights were impressive on Saturday at the Appleton Family Ice Center and rolled to a 9-0 victory.

The Green Knights scored four times in the opening 8:38 and had a 52-16 advantage in shots.

Hill had a hat trick for St. Norbert and Cooper scored two of the Green Knights' first three goals.

Jacobson improved to 8-0-0 for the season while making 16 saves for the shutout.

Soderqvist gave up the first three goals of the contest and took the loss. Anton Olsson came on in relief in the first period and finished with 41 saves for the Vikings.

Lawrence missed a great scoring chance in the first 20 seconds of the game, and St. Norbert's Ross Pavek scored at 1:09 to put the Green Knights up 1-0.

Cooper then scored at 6:35 and 8:25, and Hill got his first goal of the night at 8:38 for a 4-0 lead. St. Norbert added three more goals in the second and a pair of goals in the third period.

## VIKINGS UPDATE

►Lawrence continues to run the gauntlet of ranked teams when it heads to UW-Eau Claire on Saturday. The Blue-golds are the fourth ranked team among Lawrence's last seven opponents.



►The Vikings are looking to bounce back from a rough night against No. 1 St. Norbert last Saturday. Lawrence's 9-0 loss to the Green Knights was the worst defeat the Vikings have endured since a 10-1 setback to St. Scholastica in the 2000-01 season.

►Sophomore goaltender Mattias Soderqvist (Stockholm, Sweden) had a career night against St. Norbert last Friday at the Cornerstone Community Center. Soderqvist stopped a career-high 54 shots in Lawrence's 3-1 loss. That topped his previous best of 50 saves against MSOE on Jan. 17, 2014.

►Soderqvist is now 5-5-1 on the season with a 3.04 goals against average and .921 save percentage.

►Freshman forward Jake Kreutzer (Lake Orion, Mich.) leads the team with seven assists, and he has three goals for a team-best 10 points.

►Junior forward Renato Engler (Davos, Switzerland), who missed last Saturday's game, is second on the team in both goals (3), assists (6) and points (9).

►Lawrence ranks eighth in the NCHA in scoring offense at 2.67 goals per game. The Vikings are seventh in scoring defense at 3.42 goals per contest.

►Lawrence is seventh in the league on the penalty kill at 79.3 percent (46-58). St. Norbert scored on 4-of-14 power plays against the Vikings last weekend.

►The second period is proving to Lawrence's best offensive period this season. Lawrence has scored 15 times in the second, which is 46.9 percent of Lawrence's goals this season.

►Lawrence is eighth in the league on the power play at 13.0 percent (7-54) after going 0-for-9 on the man-advantage against St. Norbert.

### SCOUTING UW-EAU CLAIRE

►UW-Eau Claire is coming off a weekend split against a pair of WIAC foes. The Blugolds dropped a 3-0 decision at eighth-ranked UW-Stevens Point last Friday and rebounded with a 4-1 victory against visiting UW-Superior on Saturday.



►The Blugolds are 0-2-0 against NCHA teams heading into this weekend. Eau Claire lost 3-2 to St. Norbert and 5-2 to Adrian. Eau Claire faces MSOE on Friday before hosting the Vikings on Saturday.

►The top scorer for the Blugolds is junior forward Ethan Nauman, who has a team-best seven goals to go with four assists for a team-high 11 points. Nauman ranks first in the WIAC at 0.70 goals per game and second at 1.10 points per contest.

►Sophomore forward Patrick Moore is tops in the WIAC at 0.90 assists per game. Moore has nine assists and one goal for 10 points this season.
