THE COACHES

►Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert 2000) is in his 11th season at Lawrence and has a record of 111-159-24 (.418).

►Mark Ostapina (Wisconsin 1979) is in his 16th season at MSOE and has a record of 234-178-20 (.565). He is in his 23rd season overall and has a record of 297-262-28 (.530).

THE SERIES

►In a series that started in the 1992-93 season, MSOE holds a 49-21-3 advantage. The Vikings are 2-0-1 in the last three meetings with MSOE.

LAST SERIES

Eighth-ranked Adrian posted a pair of tight victories over the Vikings last weekend.

A short-handed goal early in the third period Saturday proved to be the difference as Adrian held on for 2-1 Northern Collegiate Hockey Asso-

ciation victory over Lawrence University at the Appleton Family Ice Center.

The Bulldogs broke a 1-1 tie with Taylor McCloy's short-hander just 4:30 into the final period.

The Vikings went on the power play 1:45 into the third period when Vincent Paquette was sent off for cross-checking. Adrian's Austin Rust was whistled for holding 44 seconds later, and the Vikings had a two-man advantage for the next 1:16.

Lawrence couldn't cash in on the two-man advantage, and the Bulldogs were still down a man when McCloy eased toward the Vikings' blue line just as Adrian got control of the puck. He skated in alone on Lawrence goaltender Evan Cline and scored on a back-hander at the 4:30 mark.

Lawrence had a final opportunity when Adrian's Matt McNair was whistled for slashing with 39 seconds left. The Vikings then pulled Cline and had a pair of good scoring chances. The final opportunity came on a scrum in front of the net as time expired, but Adrian goaltender Kevin Entmaa jumped on the puck seconds before the buzzer sounded.

Entmaa made 21 saves to pick up the win for Adrian, and Cline was superb in net for the Vikings as he stopped 46 of 48 shots.

Cory Dunn put Adrian on top when scored on the power play with just 1:08 left in the opening period. Lawrence tied the game at 1-1 six minutes into the second period when Josh Koeplinger beat Entmaa off assists from Carson Knop and Lane King.

Adrian scored two goals in a span of 2:51 in the third period Friday to seal a 5-3 win over Lawrence.

Adrian was hanging onto a 3-2 edge when Michael Hoy scored at the 7:56 mark to build the lead to two. Dunn then scored on a scramble near the net at the 10:47 mark for a 5-2 edge.

Lawrence battled back with the help of a pair of Adrian penalties. The Vikings got a two-man advantage for more than a minute when Adrian took two penalties within 34 seconds. Sean Reynolds cashed in for the Vikings when his shot from the high slot got past Dillon Kelley to cut the lead to 5-3 with 4:13 left.

The Vikings weren't able to pull goaltender Greg Procopio until the final 30 seconds and couldn't get any closer. Kelley made 16 saves to pick up the win, and Procopio stopped 21 shots in the loss.

Adrian grabbed an early 2-0 lead on the strength of first-period goals from Mat Thompson and Rust.

Lawrence surged to life in the opening seconds of the second period. Matt Beranek took a pass from the corner and stuffed the puck past Kelley just 22 seconds into the second to trim the lead to 2-1.

Beranek got his second goal of the night with some help from Kelley later in the second period. The Bulldogs were on the power play when the puck was played to their end of the ice. Kelley came out of the net and misplayed the puck, which was picked up by Beranek. He found the back of the open net for his first career short-handed goal to tie the game at 2-2 at the 12:50 mark.

Adrian took the lead back with 2:02 left in the period when McCloy scored on a scrum in front of the net, and that gave the Bulldogs a 3-2 lead heading to the third period.

VIKINGS UPDATE

►With six games left in the regular season, the Vikings are now five points out of playoff spot in the fourth place in the NCHA's North Division. The top three teams in each division

Josh Koepflinger (Saginaw, Mich.) saw his point streak snapped at five games but he continues to lead the team in points. Koepflinger has 16 points

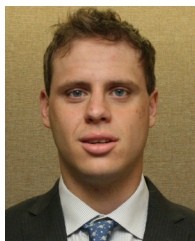

Rookie goaltender Evan Cline (Free-land, Mich.) returned from injury on Saturday and was outstanding against Adrian. He made 46 saves, his second-highest total of the season. Cline is second in the NCHA with a .934 save percentage and fourth with a 2.35 goals against average.

►Lawrence held high-scoring Adrian to just 1-for-9 on the power play last weekend. Lawrence improved to 80.6 percent (87-108) on the penalty kill this season, and that ranks sixth in the NCHA.

►Lawrence went 1-for-12 on the power play against St. Scholastica and fell to 12-for-100 (12.5 percent) on the man-advantage. That ranks 10th in the NCHA. King, Sean Reynolds (Anaheim, Calif.), Matt Montemurro (Glenview, Ill.) and rookie Evan Ketner (Washing-ton, Mich.) are tied for the team lead with two power-play goals apiece.

►Lawrence ranks ninth in the NCHA in scoring at 2.37 goals per game. The Vikings are seventh in scoring defense at 3.26 goals per contest.

►Lawrence had not allowed a short-handed goal in almost a calendar year until this past Saturday when Adrian's Taylor McCloy got a short-hander. It was the first since Adrian's Jeremy Olinky scored one on Jan. 30, 2016.

SCOUTING MSOE

►MSOE split its games last weekend with Marian. The Raiders won the opener 3-1 and dropped a 4-3 decision at Marian on Saturday. MSOE improved to 6-3-2 in its last 11 games.



►Senior forward Gage Christianson leads the Raiders in scoring with 11 goals, and he has 11 assists for a team-best 22 points. Junior forward James Ring has a team-high 12 assists to go with five goals for 17 points.
