## SCHEDULE

►The Vikings host Northland in a critical NCHA series for both teams this weekend. The puck drops Friday at 7 p.m. at the Appleton Family Ice Center, and Saturday's game is set for 4 p.m.

## THE COACHES

►Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert 2000) is in his 11th season at Lawrence and has a record of 111-160-25 (.417).

►Seamus Gregory (St. Thomas, Ontario, 2001) is in his third season at Northland and has a record of 19-43-9 (.331). He is in his fourth season overall with a record of 28-59-11 (.342).

## THE SERIES

►In a series that started in the 1997-98 season, Lawrence holds a commanding 59-15-3 advantage over the Lumberjacks. Lawrence is 3-0-2 in its last five games against Northland.

## LAST SERIES

Lawrence salvaged a point from its series with MSOE this past weekend.

Austin Frank's first goal of the season and a great effort by goaltender Evan Cline led Lawrence to a 2-2 overtime tie at MSOE last Friday.

Cline made 39 saves, including 15 in the third period, to help the Vikings to the tie.

The Vikings entered the third period trailing 2-1 when MSOE's Zach

Simpson was whistled for hooking at the 3:13 mark. Frank, a defenseman, scored on the ensuing power play to tie the game at 2-2 just 21 seconds later.

Lawrence took an early 1-0 lead on another power-play goal in the opening period. Sean Reynolds scored with assists from Daniel Gysi and Matt Beranek on Lawrence's first power-play chance of the game to take a 1-0 edge at the 15:39 mark of the first.

Lawrence went 2-for-6 on the power play, and the Vikings held MSOE to 0-for-10.

Brendan Unser tied the game at 1-1 with his goal just 2:31 into the second, and the Raiders took a 2-1 lead on Nick Redmon's short-handed goal at the 11:25 mark.

Austin Campbell stopped 15 shots for MSOE.

Campbell made 28 saves Thursday, and the Raiders posted a 3-0 victory at Lawrence.

After making just four saves in the opening period, Campbell stopped 12 shots in both the second and third to keep the Vikings off the board.

Cline stopped 21 shots and took the loss for Lawrence.

MSOE got all the offense it would need when Jerad Tafoya scored with just 23 seconds left in the opening period for a 1-0 edge. The Raiders took a 2-0 lead six minutes into the second period when Gage Christianson cashed in on a power-play change. MSOE finished 1-for-5 on the man-advantage.

Lawrence had a chance to get back into the game late in the second period when the Raiders took a pair of penalties. The Vikings had a two-man

advantage for just under a minute and a one-man advantage for another minute but couldn't score.

Connor Esciso added an insurance goal for the Raiders just 3:31 into the third period.

### VIKINGS UPDATE

►This is a make-or-break weekend series for the Vikings. Lawrence trails Northland by four points for the final playoff spot from the North Division.



St. Norbert and St. Scholastica have already clinched playoff spots. Both Lawrence and Northland have four games left in the regular season. Lawrence finishes with a home-and-home series against Lake Forest, and Northland finishes with a pair of games at Concordia.

►The Vikings got another superb effort from rookie goaltender Evan Cline (Freeland, Mich.) this past weekend. Cline posted a 2.43 goals against average and .923 save percentage for the two games. On the season, Cline has a 2.36 GAA and .932 save percentage. Cline is within striking distance of a pair of Lawrence season records. The save percentage record of .924 was set by Peter Emery in 2011-12. The GAA record of 2.11 was set by Evan Johnson in 2008-09.

►Cline's 39 saves this past Saturday is only his third-highest save total of the season. He stopped 46 against Adrian on Jan. 28 and made a season-high 49 stops in a 1-1 tie with St. Norbert on Dec. 2.

►Offensive production has been down over the past six games. Lawrence has averaged just 1.5 goals during a stretch that has seen the team post a 0-5-1 record. Lawrence has slipped to ninth in the league in scoring at 2.24 goals per game.

►The Vikings have four players in double figures in points. Sophomore forward Josh Koeplinger (Saginaw, Mich.) is tied for the team lead in both goals

and assists. Koeplinger has seven goals and 10 assists for a team-best 17 points. Senior forward Blake Roubos (Niagara Falls, Ontario) also has seven goals to go with eight assists for 15 points. Junior forward Lane King (Waunakee, Wis.) has 10 assists to go with three goals for 13 points.

►Junior Matt Montemurro (Glenview, Ill.) is the team's highest scoring defenseman with eight assists and three goals for 11 points.

►Lawrence held MSOE to just 1-for-15, including 0-for-10 on Saturday, on the power play last weekend. Lawrence improved to 82.1 percent (101-123) on the penalty kill this season, and that ranks fifth in the NCHA.

►Lawrence went 2-for-11 on the power play against MSOE and improved to 14-for-111 (12.6 percent) on the man-advantage. That ranks ninth in the NCHA. Senior forward Sean Reynolds (Anaheim, Calif.) leads the team with three power-play goals.

►Lawrence ranks eighth in the NCHA in scoring defense at 3.19 goals per contest.

### SCOUTING NORTHLAND

►Northland saw its four-game win streak snapped with a pair of losses at No. 3 St. Norbert last weekend. The Green Knights topped Northland 5-1 in the series opener and St. Norbert won the series finale 5-2. Northland managed just 41 shots total for the two games. By contrast, St. Norbert posted 42 shots in the first game of the series.

►Senior forward Michael Berens and sophomore forward Lucas DeBenedet have paced the Northland offense this season. Berens has a team-high 10 goals to go with 12 assists for 22 points. DeBenedet has handed out a team-best 14 assists to go with eight goals for 22 points.

►Northland has had some balance to its attack with eight players already reaching double figures in points.

►Sophomore Al Smith has played nearly all of the minutes in goal for the Lumberjacks. He has a 9-7-1 record to go with a 3.23 GAA and .908 save percentage.

►Northland ranks fifth in the NCHA in scoring at 3.19 goals per game. The Lumberjacks are ninth in scoring defense at 3.71 goals per game.

►The Lumberjacks have been good on the power play this season and rank fourth in the league at 19.1 percent (18-94). Northland is eighth in the conference on the penalty kill at 79.6 percent (82-103).
