THE COACHES

Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Conference Coach of the Year, is in his seventh season at Lawrence and has a record of 85-57 (.599). Skip Noon (Martin Luther 1986) is in his 22nd season at Wisconsin Lutheran and has a record of 265-290 (.477). Bob Semling (UW-Eau Claire 1981) is in his ninth season at UW-Stevens Point and has a record

of 187-47 (.799).

THE SERIES

In a series that goes back to the 1986-87 season, Lawrence holds a 13-6 edge against Wisconsin Lutheran. Lawrence has won the last six games against the Warriors. UW-Stevens Point has a 30-13 lead in the series that goes back to 1895. The Pointers have won the last four meetings with Lawrence.

LAST MEETING vs. WIS. LUTHERAN

Chris Siebert poured in 26 points to lead Lawrence to a 72-64 non-conference victory over Wisconsin Lutheran on Nov. 18, 2011, at Alexander Gymnasium.

Siebert was 10-for-16 from the floor, including 4-for-7 from 3-point

range on his way to his career high in points. Siebert also grabbed six rebounds, had four assists, two blocks and two steals.

Davis DeWolfe added 13 points and Conor Klusendorf and Ryan DePouw added 12 points apiece for Lawrence. Klusendorf also had a team-high nine rebounds.

Alex Merbach had a double-double for Wisconsin Lutheran with 28 points and 11 rebounds. Nate Bauer added 14 points for the Warriors.

Lawrence built a 13-point lead in the first half, but Wisconsin Lutheran scored 13 consecutive points to tie the game at 29-29 with 2:42 left in the opening half.

Lawrence then scored the half's final nine points, including a three-point play from Andrew Kline in the closing seconds, to lead 38-29 at the break.

Lawrence led by as many as 13 points in the second half on two occasions, but Wisconsin Lutheran would not let the Vikings pull away. The Warriors cut the lead to six points at 63-57 with 3:39 left.

DePouw answered with a 3-pointer to push the lead back to 66-57, and after a pair of missed 3-pointers, the Warriors fouled DePouw. He hit a pair of free throws with 58 seconds left to give the Vikings a 68-58 lead.

After a free throw by the Warriors, DeWolfe got a fastbreak layup with 35 seconds left to give Lawrence a 70-59 lead and seal the victory.

LAST MEETING vs. UWSP

No. 15 UW-Stevens Point pulled away early in the second half and then shut down a late Lawrence rally for a 72-64 nonconference victory on Nov. 15, 2012, at Alexander Gymnasium.

All-American Tyler Tillema, Trevor Hass and Clayton Heuer scored 14 points apiece to lead the Pointers.

Davis DeWolfe scored 23 points and hit 8 of 10 shots from the floor to pace Lawrence. Freshman Jamie Nikitas came off the bench and added 11 points and Chris Siebert had 10.

lead at 21-11 with 10:04 left in the first half, but the Pointers dominated the rest of the first half. Stevens Point went on an 18-2 run to finish the half and led 29-23 at the break.

The Pointers then scored the first five points of the second half to pull ahead 36-23 with 18:11 remaining. Lawrence finally got its offense back in gear, but the Pointers would steadily build their lead to as many as

18 points midway through the second half.

Sparked by Nikitas, Lawrence went on a 7-0 run to trim the lead to 53-42 on a pair of Siebert free throws with 8:13 left. Lawrence kept chipping away and cut the lead to 58-51 when Nikitas hit a 3-pointer with 2:54 remaining.

DeWolfe then scored the next six points for the Vikings to cut the margin to 62-57 with 1:25 left. The Vikings had a chance to cut further into the margin, but Nikitas missed a pair of free throws with 48 seconds left.

Stevens Point then hit 10 consecutive free throws in the final 46 seconds to seal the victory.

LAST GAME

Lawrence pulled away early in overtime and used clutch free-throw shooting to post a 114-106 Midwest Conference victory over Grinnell on Feb. 16, 2013, in the season finale at Alexander Gymnasium.

Senior forward Conor Klusendorf, playing in his final game for Lawrence, led the Vikings with 21 points and he added eight rebounds. Tyler Mazur scored 20 points and pulled down a game-high nine rebounds for the Vikings.

Freshman guard Jamie Nikitas added 19 points for the Vikings and was clutch at the foul line in the overtime, going 7-for-8 from the line in the extra period. Ryan DePouw added 18 points and Chris Siebert, who battled foul trouble all afternoon, had 14 points. Brian Gryszkiewicz picked up nine assists and five steals for the Vikings.

Griffin Lentsch paced Grinnell with 27 points, and Patrick Maher added 25 for the Pioneers. The loss was costly for Grinnell, which lost a share of the Midwest Conference championship and the right to host the conference tournament.

Grinnell pulled away late in the first half as the Pioneers broke a 39-39 tie with a 20-6 run for a 59-45 lead. The Vikings recovered in the final minute with baskets from Chase Nelson and

Troy Miller to trim the margin to 59-50 at the half.

Grinnell shot 19-for-38 in the first half, including 8-for-17 from beyond the 3-point line. The Pioneers cooled off a bit in the second half, and Lawrence shot itself back into the game.

The Vikings went on a 15-4 run that included three 3-pointers from Siebert, to take a 71-70 lead with 11:28 left in the second half. Lawrence pushed the lead to 88-80 on Mazur's 3-pointer with 5:10 left, but Grinnell battled back.

The Pioneers went on an 11-1 run, capped by Maher's 3-pointer, to take a 91-89 lead with 1:54 remaining in the second half. Lawrence got a pair of free throws from DePouw and a steal and layup from Gryszkiewicz to lead 93-91 with 1:11 left.

The Vikings led 95-92 after two Gryszkiewicz free throws with 20 seconds left, but Jesse Ney hit a 3-pointer with seven seconds left to tie it and force the overtime.

with a dunk from Klusendorf and a nifty bank shot from Siebert. Klusendorf followed with a layup while Grinnell missed its first three shots from the floor, and the Vikings led 101-95 with 3:21 left.

Joe Rogers hit one free throw for Grinnell, but the Vikings spent the rest of the overtime at the foul line. Lawrence went 11-for-12 from the line in the final 2:47 of overtime to seal the victory.

Grinnell hit just 3-of-12 shots from the floor in the overtime and turned the ball over three times.

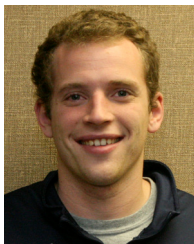
Lawrence finished the game 30-of-44 (68.2 percent) from the foul line, and the Vikings shot 58.7 percent (37-63) from the floor.

VIKINGS UPDATE

▶Lawrence opens its season with games on consecutive nights for the first time since the 2007-08 season. Lawrence won both of its games that season, defeating Dominican (Ill.) 87-72 on the first night and then beating Concordia (Ill.) 72-68 the following night.

▶This is one of the largest senior classes in recent history. The Vikings have eight seniors on the squad. Lawrence hasn't had more than six seniors on a team over the past 15 years. The two largest senior classes in this very successful era were the 2009-10 group of John Dekker, Drew Shaw, Tyler Cullitan, Yui Ueno, Dustin Lee and Jamie DeMatthew and the 2007-08 team with Andy Hurley, Ryan Wendel, Tommy Schmidt, Dylan Fogel, Ben Rosenblatt and George Hogen.

▶Senior guard Chris Siebert (Baraboo, Wis./Baraboo) enters this season with 948 points. An All-Midwest Conference selection each of the last two sea-

sons, Siebert needs just 52 points to be the 21st player in Lawrence history to score 1,000 points. Siebert needs 58 points to pass Rob Cohen (1,005) points for 20th place on Lawrence's career scoring list.

►Siebert is one of four returning starters for the Vikings this season. The Vikings also bring back senior guard Brian Gryszkiewicz (Menomonee Falls, Wis./Sussex Hamilton), senior forward Davis DeWolfe (Green Bay, Wis./Southwest) and junior guard Ryan DePouw (Oconto, Wis./Oconto). DeWolfe started the first 13 games of last season before being sidelined by injury.

►Lawrence returns more than 80 percent of its scoring and rebounding from a season ago. Forward Conor Klusendorf was the lone starter lost from a season ago, and the Vikings will miss his 12.2 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. Klusendorf also brought a defensive presence around the basket and blocked 29 shots last season.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN LUTHERAN

►Wisconsin Lutheran tips off its season at Lawrence coming off a 9-16 record in 2012-13. Wisconsin Lutheran's top three scorers from last season, Tim Demuth, Nate Bauer and Russell Strutz, were all lost to graduation.

►The Warriors return only one starter from last season in forward Brett Lubbe. He averaged 6.3 points and 6.6 rebounds per game last season.

►The other returning players with substantial playing time a season ago are junior guard Taylor Chladek and sophomore forward Kyle Stelse.

►The other two probable starters for the Warriors weren't on the team last season. Guard Jake Jarnigo was at UW-Whitewater for the last two years but didn't play basketball for the Warhawks. Sophomore center Jim Marose was a standout at UW-Waukesha last

season.

SCOUTING UW-STEVENSON POINT

►The Pointers return a formidable squad for the upcoming season. UW-Stevens Point is ranked fourth in the D3hoops.com preseason poll. Stevens Point was ranked 15th in the final poll of the 2012-13 season. The Pointers finished the 2012-13 season with a 67-58 loss to Calvin in the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.



►The Pointers won the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference title last season and were the pick to win it again this year in the preseason poll of the league coaches and sports information directors. The Pointers have collected a league-high 27 WIAC regular-season championships, including nine of the last 14.

►The Pointers return four starters and 80.0 percent of their scoring from last year's team that finished second in the NCAA Division III with a 77.5 free-throw shooting percentage and third with 9.7 turnovers per game.

►The Pointers have about 80 percent of their scoring back from a season ago. Senior Trevor Hass, junior Joe Ritchay and senior Clayton Heuer finished second (11.6 ppg), third (11.2 ppg) and fourth (10.4 ppg), respectively, on the team in scoring a year ago. Also back from injury is senior Tyler Tillema, who played in nine games and posted 18.0 points per contest.

►The Pointers have put won at least 20 games in seven of eight seasons under head coach Bob Semling, who is 13 wins away from the 200-victory plateau. Jack Bennett is the career wins leader at UWSP with a mark of 200-56 over nine seasons.
