## THE COACHES

▶Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Conference Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 117-94 (.555).

▶Skip Noon (Martin Luther 1986) is in his 25th season at Wisconsin Lutheran and has a record of 302-331 (.477).

## THE SERIES

▶Lawrence has a 15-7 lead in the series, which started in the 1986-87 season. The Vikings had won seven consecutive games against the Warriors

before Wisconsin Lutheran pulled off a 71-70 upset at Alexander Gymnasium last season. The Vikings missed a 3-pointer at the buzzer that would have won it.

## LAST GAME

Troy Miller scored a career-high 27 points in his final game to lead Lawrence to a 96-89 Midwest Conference overtime victory in the season finale at Monmouth on Feb. 20, 2016.

Miller, a senior guard, went 8-for-11 from the floor on nothing but 3-point attempts to eclipse his previous career high of 21 points. The eight 3-pointers ties the second-highest game total in Lawrence history and is a personal best for Miller, who hit seven triples in a game last season.

Jeremy Stephani added 19 points for the Vikings, and Jamie Nikitas had 18 points before fouling out. Nikitas finished his career with 1,406 points, good for fourth on Lawrence's career list. He also shattered the season record with 577 points and the scoring average record at 25.1 per game.

Ben Peterson picked up 13 points

and a game-high eight rebounds for Lawrence before he fouled out, and Connor Weas added 11 points and seven boards.

Lamont Mitchell and Matt Juhola scored 18 points apiece for the Scots.

Lawrence rallied from a nine-point deficit in the final five minutes of regulation and nearly won the game without an overtime. The Vikings were down 71-62 when they went on a 7-1 run courtesy of a 3-pointer and a pair of free throws from Stephani and Evan McLaughlin's layup.

Mitchell and Miller traded 3-pointers, and the Vikings tied it at 77-77 on another Stephani 3-pointer with 1:29 left. Miller then hit a 3-pointer and added a free throw to give Lawrence an 81-77 edge with 45 seconds left.

Monmouth's Will Jones converted a three-point play, and after the Vikings turned it over, Mitchell hit a jumper for an 82-81 lead. McLaughlin was fouled with six seconds left and made one free throw to tie it. Jon Calhoun was short on a layup at the buzzer that would have won it for Monmouth.

The game was tied at 87-87 in overtime when the Vikings took over. Stephani hit a jumper in the lane, and Miller drained a long 3-pointer to put the Vikings up 92-87 with 53 seconds left.

After a Monmouth miss, the Scots were forced to foul. Lawrence hit just 4-of-8 free throws in the final 42 seconds but that was enough as Monmouth had a turnover and a pair of missed 3-pointers to finish the game.

## VIKINGS UPDATE

►Lawrence enters this season as a team of two halves. The Vikings have eight returning players to form the backbone of the team and eight new players that bring some exciting possibilities. Among the eight returning players, the Vikings basically have four returning starters and all but one returning player started at least one game a sea-

ference selection, and Miller averaged 9.4 points per game.

▶The top returning scorer for the Vikings is junior guard Jeremy Stephani (Arlington Heights, Ill./Wheeling), who averaged 11.5 points per game while shooting 37.6 percent from the floor. He is joined by other returning shooters Connor Weas (Whitefish Bay, Wis./Whitefish Bay) and Ben Peterson (River Forest, Ill./Fenwick).

▶Senior Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) is the top returning rebounder at 5.3 per game and he picked up 1.1 blocks per game.

▶The Vikings do return two key performers to the lineup this season. Senior forward Pete Winslow (Evanston, Ill./Evanston Township) was limited to 16 games last season due to injury, and guard Eric Weiss (Birmingham, Mich./Bloomfield Hills) played in only 15 games.

▶Lawrence ranked fourth in the league in scoring defense last season at 71.7 points per game, and the Vikings were 10th in scoring offense at 70.2 points per contest.

▶Lawrence shot 43.8 percent from the floor, good for eighth in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings were second in field goal percentage defense at 42.3 percent.

▶Lawrence shot 32.7 percent from 3-point range, and that ranked eighth in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings were eighth in defending the 3-pointer at 35.4 percent.

▶Lawrence is 67-47 in season openers, including a 5-4 mark under head coach Joel DePagter.

Warriors finish fourth in the Northern Athletics Conference. Wisconsin Lutheran was picked for fifth place in the league, and Benedictine was chosen to repeat as the champion.

▶The Warriors return two double-figure scorers from a season ago. Forward Collin Kennedy led the team in scoring at 19.4 points per game to go with 6.1 rebounds per game. Junior Chase Nowak averaged 12.1 points and 4.0 rebounds per game last season.

▶Guard Tanner Schieve will direct the Wisconsin Lutheran attack and is coming off a season where he averaged 9.3 points and 4.2 assists per game.

▶The Warriors averaged 75.7 points per game last season while shooting 43.2 percent from the floor. Wisconsin Lutheran shot 30.4 percent from beyond the arc a season ago and hit at a 68.1 percent clip from the foul line.
