THE COACHES

▶ Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Conference Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 120-100 (.548).

►Todd Skrivseth (Coe 1996) is in his sixth season at Monmouth and has a record of 51-74 (.408).

THE SERIES

Monmouth has a 70-40 lead in a se-

ries that started in 1926, but Lawrence has had the better of the rivalry over the last decade-plus. Lawrence is 19-5, including a 12-game win streak mixed in there, against the Scots since the start of the 2002-03 season.

LAST GAME

Lawrence pulled away in the final five minutes Monday to post a 68-61 Midwest Conference victory over Knox at Alexander Gymnasium.

The Vikings got a late 10-2 run featuring key baskets from Jeremy Stephani and Ben Peterson to take the lead and maintain control over a scrappy Knox squad.

Stephani led four Vikings in double figures with 15 points. Mitch Willer added a double-double of 11 points and a game-high 11 rebounds for Lawrence. Quinn Fisher picked up 13 points, and Pete Winslow added 11 points and nine rebounds for the Vikings.

Marko Protic scored 17 points to pace Knox.

After 13 lead changes and six ties, Knox led 55-53 before Willer's layup tied it with 5:06 left. Stephani then converted a critical three-point play to put the Vikings up 58-55 with 4:19 remaining.

The teams then traded a pair of free throws before Peterson buried a 3-pointer from the left wing very late in the shot clock to put Lawrence up 63-57 with 2:26 left. Peterson finished with nine points, going 3-for-7 from beyond the arc, and added five rebounds.

Jonathan Damota countered with a layup for the Prairie Fire, but Knox misfired on its next three shots and was forced to foul. Fisher went 4-for-5 from the line and Willer was 1-for-2 in the final 40 seconds to seal the victorv.

Lawrence, playing its third game in five days, went 15-for-21 from the foul line for the game. Lawrence put together one of its best rebounding games of the season, and the Vikings were a plus-12 on the glass (41-29).

Lawrence swept the season series from the Prairie Fire, and the Vikings have now won 11 straight and 27 of the last 30 against Knox.

VIKINGS UPDATE

The Vikings snapped a four-game losing streak with the win over Knox in a very rare Monday afternoon meeting. Lawrence continued its mastery over the Prai-



rie Fire in recent years with its 11th consecutive win over Knox. The Vikings have now won 27 of the last 30 against the Prairie Fire, and Lawrence now trails the all-time series 61-60.

Senior forward Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) continues to lead the Vikings in both scoring and rebounding while shooting a very high Mitch Willer

▶ Rookie guard Quinn Fisher (La-Grange, III./Fenwick) is averaging 4.4 assists per game, good for fourth in the Midwest Conference.

Lawrence is seventh in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 80.1 points per game. The Vikings are eighth in scoring at 74.0 points per game.

Lawrence ranks second in the Midwest Conference in field goal percentage defense at 40.7 percent. The Vikings are third in the conference in field goal percentage at 48.7 percent.

Lawrence is shooting 34.3 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks seventh in the conference. The Vikings are second in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 34.9 percent.

SCOUTING MONMOUTH

The Scots have lost four straight, including three close defeats.



Monmouth is coming off a 66-62 loss to Illinois Tech and dropped its last Midwest Conference game, an 81-75 defeat at Knox. Monmouth faces Lake Forest on Wednesday before it hosts Lawrence this weekend.

The Scots get the bulk of their offensive production from four players, Will Jones, Lamont Mitchell, Justin Aluya and Paul Engo. Jones is at 16.7 points per game, and Mitchell is right on his heels at 16.3. Aluya is at 13.3 and Engo is averaging 9.3 points per game. That accounts for 75 percent of Monmouth's scoring.
