#### **THE COACHES**

▶ Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Conference Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 117-95 (.552).

▶Bob Semling (UW-Eau Claire 1981) is in his 12th season at UW-Stevens Point and has a record of 257-68 (.791).

#### **THE SERIES**

In one of the oldest series on the books at Lawrence, UW-Stevens Point holds a 33-13 edge over the Vikings. First played in 1896, the Vikings and Pointers have been regular opponents over the past decade-plus. The biggest game in the series was Stevens Point's 82-81 overtime victory

in the Elite Eight of the 2004 NCAA Division III Tournament at the University of Puget Sound. Stevens Point has won the last seven meetings, and Lawrence's last victory was a 75-59 win at Alexander Gymnasium early in the 2008-09 campaign.

#### **LAST GAME**

Wisconsin Lutheran held off Lawrence 76-68 in a nonconference game last Wednesday in the season opener at the Recreation Complex.

The Warriors went on a 13-4 run over a five-minute stretch to take a 67-58 lead with less than three minutes left. Lawrence hit a pair of 3-pointers in the final two minutes to get within four points twice but could get no closer.

Collin Kennedy and Tanner Schieve scored 17 points apiece to pace Wisconsin Lutheran. Kennedy also had a game-high 11 rebounds.

Jeremy Stephani led Lawrence with 16 points, and Mitch Willer added 12 points, three rebounds and three blocks. Evan McLaughlin added 10 points for the Vikings, who hit just



8-of-35 shots (22.9 percent) from beyond the arc.

A pair of Willer free throws cut Wisconsin Lutheran's lead to 55-54 with 7:50 remaining. The Warriors then went on the decisive run, hitting six consecutive free throws during that stretch, to stretch the lead to nine with 2:47 left.

The Vikings battled back as Pete Winslow hit a 3-pointer to trim the lead to 68-63. Rookie Quinn Fisher hit another 3-pointer for Lawrence to cut the lead to 70-66 with 45 seconds left.

The Warriors then hit six consecutive free throws in the final 31 seconds to seal the win. Wisconsin Lutheran went 28-for-35 from the foul line in the game. Lawrence went 12-for-15.

In the opening half, Wisconsin Lutheran built a 29-20 lead with less than four minutes left before Lawrence rallied.

Connor Weas scored four points and Fisher hit a 3-pointer to spark an 11-2 run that allowed Lawrence to forge a 31-31 tie at the break.

#### **VIKINGS UPDATE**

▶Lawrence got off to a rough start shooting the basketball in the season opener at Wisconsin Lutheran. The Vikings hit on just 8-of-35 shots from 3-point



range against the Warriors. That's an icy 22.9 percent. On the flip side, the Vikings were very good inside the arc. Lawrence hit 16-of-25 on its 2-point field goals attempts for a hot 64 percent.

▶Rookie guard Quinn Fisher (La-Grange, Ill./Fenwick) joined some elite company when he started the season opener. Fisher is the first freshman to start for the Vikings since Jostens Trophy winner Chris Braier and Kyle MacGillis started against MSOE in the 2002-03 season opener. Fisher had a solid showing in his first game as he scored eight points on 3-for-8 shooting. He added four rebounds, three assists and one steal against two turn-

er, who had 24 blocks a season ago, picked up three blocks against the Warriors. Ben Peterson (River Forest, Ill./Fenwick) and Evan McLaughlin (La-Grange, III./Nazareth) had two blocks apiece, and the Vikings finished with eight in the game.

▶Lawrence ranked fourth in the league in scoring defense last season at 71.7 points per game, and the Vikings were 10th in scoring offense at 70.2 points per contest.

▶ Lawrence shot 43.8 percent from the floor, good for eighth in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings were second in field goal percentage defense at 42.3 percent.

▶Lawrence shot 32.7 percent from 3-point range, and that ranked eighth in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings were eighth in defending the 3-pointer at 35.4 percent.

▶Lawrence fell to 67-48 in season openers, including a 5-5 mark under head coach Joel DePagter.

#### **SCOUTING UW-STEVENS POINT**

▶The Pointers already have three games under their belts and season



played in the Hoopsville National Invitational Classic in Owings Mills, Md., last weekend. The Pointers split the games, opening with a 71-51 loss to Christopher Newport before topping Lynchburg 83-73.

▶ Sophomores Ethan Bublitz and Mark Nelson are the team's leading scorers early this season. Bublitz is averaging 16.3 points per game while shooting 39 percent from the floor. Nelson is at 10.7 points per game while shooting a solid 56.3 percent from the field.

The top rebounder on the squad is Zack Goedeke at 7.0 per game, and he's averaging 6.3 points per contest.

Drew Fredrickson is the top assist man on the squad at 3.3 per game.

Stevens Point is averaging 63 points per game while shooting 38.7 percent from the floor. The Pointers are allowing 69 points per game, and opponents are hitting 48.7 percent of their shots from the floor.

▶ Stevens Point is shooting 40.3 percent from 3-point range, and Bublitz has made a team-best seven shots from beyond the arc this season. Opponents are hitting at 39.3 percent from beyond the arc.

Stevens Point was chosen for sixth place in the eight-team Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in a preseason poll of league coaches and sports information directors. UW-Oshkosh, coached by Lawrence alumnus and former assistant coach Pat Juckem, was the preseason favorite to win the league.
