# **THE COACHES**

▶ Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Confer-

ence Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 121-100 (.548).

► Chad Murray (Chapman 1998) is in his eighth season at Cornell and has a record of 64-115 (.358).

Mike Worrell (Urbana 1986) is in his 21st season at Illinois College and has a record of 197-277 (.416).

# **THE SERIES**

Cornell holds a commanding 61-29 lead in a series that goes back to 1924. The Vikings are 3-3 against the Rams since Cornell rejoined the Midwest Conference.


In a series that started in 1985-86, Lawrence holds a 35-10 advantage over the Blueboys. Lawrence has won 11 straight and 23 of the last 25 against Illinois College.

#### LAST GAME

Lawrence turned back Monmouth last Saturday and scored a 66-62 Midwest Conference victory at Glennie Gymnasium.

Ben Peterson led three Vikings in double figures with 14 points and hit 5-of-7 shots from the floor, including 4-of-6 from 3-point range. Jeremy Stephani added 12 points and Eric

Weiss had 10 for the Vikings. Mitch Willer chipped in with nine points and a teamhigh eight rebounds for Lawrence.

18 points and added *Eric Weiss* eight rebounds but

committed a key turnover in the final seconds.

Lawrence built its biggest lead at 58-47 on Stephani's 3-pointer with eight minutes remaining, but the Scots kept chipping away at the lead.

Justin Aluya's two free throws cut Lawrence's lead to 61-58 with 2:50 remaining, but Weiss answered with a short jumper for Lawrence. Aluya added another free throw to cut the lead to 63-59 with 1:24 left.

Thanks to a missed shot and a turnover from both teams, the score stayed the same until Mitchell made two free throws with 34 seconds left to cut the lead to 63-61.

Lawrence's Quinn Fisher was fouled but missed the front end of a bonus. The Vikings forced a Monmouth turnover, and Fisher was fouled again. He made one free throw with 14 seconds remaining to push the lead to 64-61.

Mitchell was fouled with eight seconds left but made just one free throw to cut the margin to 64-62. Peterson grabbed Mitchell's miss and was fouled but missed the front end of the bonus to give Monmouth another chance.

Lawrence's defense stymied Mitchell, who was called for a travel with four seconds remaining. Weiss then made a pair of free throws to seal

Lawrence led from the opening minute, and the Vikings were up by as many as seven points in the first half. The Scots rallied and tied the game at 31-31 at the half.

▶The Vikings face a pair of critical games this weekend as both teams, Cornell and Illinois College, are below Lawrence in the standings. A win over Cornell



would be important as the Rams will certainly be a contender for one of the four spots in the Midwest Conference Tournament.

▶ Senior forward Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) continues to lead the team in scoring and rebounds. Willer ranks 13th in the Midwest Confer- Mitch Willer



ence in scoring at

14.1 points per game and is third in rebounding at 7.7 per contest. Willer's 63.7 field goal percentage ranks second in the league.

Willer also is second in the Midwest Conference at 1.8 blocks per game. Willer now has 61 blocks for his career and is one shy of tying Mike McGivern for third on the career list.

▶ Junior forward Ben Peterson (River For-III./Fenwick) est, continues to be one of the top 3-point shooters in the nation. Peterson ranks eighth in NCAA Di- Ben Peterson vision III in 3-point



shooting at 52.9 percent and has hit 27-of-51 shots from beyond the arc this season. Peterson is averaging 11.5 points and 6.4 rebounds while shooting 54.2 percent from the floor.

▶ Rookie guard Quinn Fisher (La-Grange, Ill./Fenwick) is averaging 4.1 assists per game, good for fourth in the Midwest Conference.

biggest game of the season in Lawrence's win at Monmouth last Saturday. Weiss scored a season-high 10 points and grabbed three rebounds in just 14 minutes of action. He went 3-for-4 from the floor, including 2-for-2 from beyond the arc.

Junior forward Evan McLaughlin (La-Grange, III./Nazareth) made his first start of the season at Monmouth and picked up three points, five rebounds and two assists in 30 minutes.

Lawrence is eighth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 78.3 points per game. The Vikings are eighth in scoring at 73.2.

Lawrence ranks second in the Midwest Conference in field goal percentage defense at 40.8 percent. The Vikings are third in the conference in field goal percentage at 48.3 percent.

Lawrence is shooting 35.5 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks

fifth in the conference. The Vikings are third in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 34.4 percent.

## **SCOUTING CORNELL**

The Rams have won two straight after a 73-43 rout of Knox this past Saturday. All five starters scored in double figures for Cornell, which got just four points from its reserves in the game.



▶ Cornell gets 80 percent of its scoring from its starting five, compared to 62.2 percent for Lawrence. Big man Jon Anderson leads Cornell in scoring at 16.4 points per game while shooting a league-best 72 percent from the floor. Anderson also is the team's leading rebounder at 7.3 per game.

The top 3-point shooters for the Rams are Grant Anderson and Jan Siegien. Anderson is hitting 48.8 percent from beyond the arc, and Siegien is at 44.1 percent. Siegien has a teambest 26 3-pointers this season.

Cornell ranks third in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 75.7 points per game. The Rams are seventh in scoring defense at 77.3 points per contest.

Cornell is second in the league in shooting at 49.1 percent. The Rams are fourth in field goal percentage defense at 43.4 percent.

The Rams rank second in the conference in 3-point shooting at 38.3 percent. Cornell is eighth in defending the 3-pointer at 38.6 percent.

#### **SCOUTING ILLINOIS COLLEGE**

The Blueboys dropped their second consecutive game with an 82-74 defeat at the hands of visiting Beloit this past Saturday. Tim Schap-



paugh led four Illinois College players in double figures with 17 points. Mason Speer and Payton Dugan are the Blueboys' leading scorers. Speer is averaging a team-high 12.4 points per game, and Dugan is at 11.5 points per contest. Speer also is averaging a team-high 3.7 assists per game.

Speer has made a team-high 20 3-pointers this season, and Stutsman is tops on the team in shooting the 3-pointer at 45.8 percent.

The Blueboys are a minus-2.5 in rebounding margin and do not have a player averaging at least five rebounds per game. Max Stutsman is tops on the team at 4.9 rebounds per contest.

Illinois College ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 74.1 points per game. The Blueboys are sixth in scoring defense at 77.3 points per contest.

▶Illinois College is shooting 43.3 percent from the floor, good for seventh in the conference. The Blueboys are seventh in field goal percentage defense at 46.3 percent.

The Blueboys are shooting 35.6 percent from 3-point range, good for fourth in the league. Illinois College is ninth in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 38.9 percent.
