THE COACHES

►Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Confer-

ence Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 123-100 (.552).

►Ken Davis (Arizona State) is in his third season at Lake Forest and has a record of 29-29 (.500).

►Brian Vraney (Wisconsin 1998) is in his 10th season at Beloit and has a record of 79-141 (.359).

THE SERIES

►Lawrence holds a 58-50 edge over Lake Forest in a series that dates back to the 1915-16 season. The Vikings have a 9-7 advantage over Lake Forest during the tenure of head coach Joel DePagter.

►In a series that started during the winter of 1911-12, Beloit holds a 101-74 advantage. Lawrence has had the better of the rivalry over the past 15

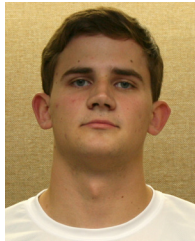
years. Lawrence has won 23 of the last 27, and included in that record is a 16-game Vikings' win streak.

LAST GAME

Lawrence opened the second half Saturday with a 3-point shooting blitz, and that sparked the Vikings to a 63-54 Midwest Conference win over Illinois College at Alexander Gymnasium.

Lawrence made its first five 3-point attempts and seven of its first eight in the opening five minutes of the second half to turn 10-point deficit into a five-point lead. The Vikings went 8-for-15 from beyond the arc in the second half.

Pete Winslow had his second consecutive hot shooting night for Lawrence. Winslow went 6-for-10 from the floor, including 5-for-7 from 3-point range, to finish with 17 points. Winslow went 5-for-6 on 3-pointers in Friday's win over Cornell to finish 10-for-13 from long distance in the two games.

Jeremy Stephani led Lawrence and all scorers with 23 points and added six rebounds and three assists with no turnovers in 34 minutes.

Mason Speer scored the first 11 points for Illinois College and finished with 22. Mitchell Patterson added 15 points and eight rebounds for the Blueboys.

Lawrence struggled mightily in the first half and trailed 30-20 at the break. After the Vikings missed the opening shot of the second half, Winslow grabbed the rebound and Stephani drained a 3-pointer.

That started a 21-6 outburst for the Vikings over the first 4:52 of the half. Winslow then hit a triple and rookie Quinn Fisher followed with another 3-pointer. Winslow then buried back-to-back 3-pointers before a miss by Stephani. Stephani came right back to hit back-to-back 3-pointers and Lawrence led 41-36.

Illinois College recovered and tied the game for the final time at 43-43 with 11:26 left. The Vikings then inched away as Illinois College missed its next five shots from the floor and committed a pair of turnovers.

Connor Weas went 4-for-4 from the foul line, and the Vikings got baskets from Winslow and Eric Weiss to build a 51-44 lead with 6:25 left.

The Blueboys closed to within 53-47 on a pair of Tim Parks free throws with 3:29 left, but Winslow countered by draining another 3-pointer. Speer made a very long 3-pointer to get the Blueboys to within 57-52, but the Vikings sealed the win at the foul line.

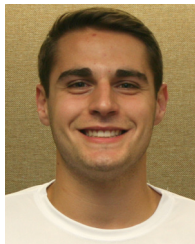
VIKINGS UPDATE

►The Vikings are off to one of their best starts in Midwest Conference play in recent years. Lawrence hasn't been 6-2 in the league since the 2010-11 season. That team started 5-0 against league foes and reached 7-2 in conference play. They finished 10-8 and in a tie for fifth place in the league standings.



►What a weekend for senior swingman Pete Winslow (Evanston, Ill./Evanston Township). Winslow averaged 18 points and five rebounds per game while shooting 65 percent from the floor, including a blistering 76.9 percent (10-13) from 3-point range. Winslow had entered play last weekend averaging 8.2 points per game. Before draining 10 3-pointers in the last two games, Winslow had made seven shots from beyond the arc in the previous 10 games. Winslow is now averaging 9.8 points per game and has improved his 3-point shooting percentage to 43.6.

►Junior guard Jeremy Stephani (Arlington Heights, Ill./Wheeling) moved into the team lead in scoring at 13.2 points per game. Stephani had his eight-game streak

of scoring in double figures broken with eight points against Cornell, but he bounced back in a big way against Illinois College. Stephani scored a career-high 23 points in the victory over the Blueboys. Stephani's previous high was 22 points at Grinnell in the 2014-15 season.

►Senior forward Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) moved past Mike McGivern into third place on the career blocks list after picking up four

in the past two games. Willer has 65 for his career and needs 11 more to catch Erik Borresen for second place. Willer is tied for first in the Midwest Conference at 1.8 blocks per game.

►The Vikings are 3-0 with junior forward Evan McLaughlin (LaGrange, Ill./Nazareth) in the starting lineup. McLaughlin has averaged 4.0 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists during those three games.

►Lawrence is fourth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 74.4 points per game. The Vikings are ninth in scoring at 71.3.

►Lawrence ranks second in the Midwest Conference in field goal percentage defense at 39.4 percent. The Vikings are shooting 46.6 percent from the floor, good for fourth in the conference.

►Lawrence is shooting 36.1 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks

fourth in the conference. The Vikings are second in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 32.2 percent.

SCOUTING LAKE FOREST

▶The Foresters stayed hot by winning both games last weekend. Lake Forest has won two straight and six of their last seven. Lake Forest topped Grinnell 109-105 last Friday and then roughed up Knox 79-53 on Saturday.



▶The Foresters are paced by the great duo of Danny Sotos and Jim Schick. Sotos leads the team in scoring at 14.8 points per game and Schick is at 11.7 per contest. Schick also is the top rebounder in the Midwest Conference at 9.6 per contest.

▶Sotos ranks fifth in the league in field goal percentage at 50.6 percent.

▶The top 3-point shooter for the Foresters is Eric Porter. He has hit 31-of-74 from beyond the arc for 41.9 percent.

▶Lake Forest is third in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 77.2 points per game. The Foresters are giving up 76.4 points per contest.

▶Lake Forest is shooting 47.4 percent from the floor, and that ranks third in the conference. The Foresters are fourth in field goal percentage defense at 42.7 percent.

▶The Foresters are second in the league in 3-point shooting at 38.1 percent. Lake Forest is seventh in defending the 3-pointer at 36.8 percent.

SCOUTING BELOIT

▶Beloit saw its two-game win streak snapped this past Saturday with a 111-92 loss to visiting Grinnell. The Bucs travel to Cornell on Wednesday before hosting Lawrence on Saturday.



▶Beloit has one of the Midwest Conference's top scorers in Cody Risseeuw. He ranks fourth in the conference in scoring at 18.8 points per game. Risseeuw is the team's top 3-point shooter at 41 percent and has hit 34-of-83 from beyond the arc.

▶Andrew Bremer, who followed his older brother, David, to Beloit, is also in double figures at 12.6 points per game. Bremner, who is shooting 51.8 percent from the floor, ranks second in the league in rebounding at 9.1 per contest.

▶Beloit is scoring 74.3 points per game, good for fourth in the Midwest Conference. The Bucs are eighth in scoring defense at 78.5 points per game.

▶Beloit is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, and that ranks fifth in the conference. The Bucs are sixth in field goal percentage defense at 44.9 percent.

▶Beloit is shooting 33.2 percent from beyond the arc, and that ranks eighth in the conference. The Bucs are third in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 34 percent.
