►Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Confer-

ence Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 124-101 (.551).

►Gary Grzesk (UWGB 1996) is in his 11th season at St. Norbert and has a record of 206-64 (.763). He is in his 14th season overall and has a record of 257-95 (.730).

►David Arseneault Jr. (Grinnell 2009) is the interim head coach at Grinnell.

THE SERIES

►St. Norbert holds a 58-46 lead in a series that started in 1918. The Green Knights have won the last 15 meetings.

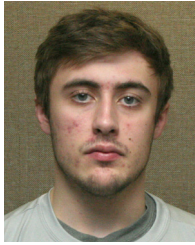
►In a series that started in 1940, Grinnell holds a 53-50 advantage over the Vikings. Lawrence holds an 18-16 edge in games vs. Grinnell's "system."

LAST GAME

Lawrence led for the final 38 minutes this past Saturday, but the Vikings had to hold off Beloit in a nail-biting 62-58 Midwest Conference victory at Flood Arena.

Lawrence never led by more than eight points and saw its lead cut to one in the final minute. The Vikings went 8-for-8 from the foul line in the final 48 seconds to secure the victory.

Rookie guard Quinn Fisher came off the bench to score a game-high 18 points for the Vikings. Lawrence's Jeremy Stephani hit a trio of 3-pointers on his way to 17 points, and he grabbed a team-high seven rebounds.



Carlton Henning *Quinn Fisher*

posted a double-double of 15 points and 10 rebounds to pace Beloit.

Beloit scored the first basket of the game, and Stephani gave Lawrence the lead for good with a 3-pointer with 18:09 left in the opening half. Lawrence led by as many as eight points three times in the first half and settled for a 37-31 lead at the break.

Lawrence led 47-40 on Fisher's 3-pointer with 11:09 remaining, but Beloit chipped away at the advantage. The Bucs went on an 8-2 run to trim the margin to 49-48, but Pete Winslow and Evan McLaughlin countered with jumpers for the Vikings to push the lead to 53-48.

The Vikings led 56-52 before Cody Risseuw hit a 3-pointer to cut the lead to one with 30 seconds left.

The Bucs fouled Ben Peterson, who made both free throws with 23 seconds remaining for a 58-55 lead. Beloit's Mike Gulve made one free throw with 10 seconds left to cut the lead to 58-56, and the Bucs then fouled Stephani.

Stephani made both free throws with eight seconds left to move the lead back to 60-56. After Mike Noyce's layup with three seconds left cut the lead back to 60-58, the Bucs fouled

higher by averaging 15.5 points over the two games last week. Stephani leads the team at 13.5 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor. Stephani also grabbed a season-best seven rebounds at Beloit and is averaging 4.4 rebounds on the season.

►Stephani, junior forward Ben Peterson (River Forest, Ill./Fenwick) and rookie guard Quinn Fisher (LaGrange, Ill./Fenwick) continue to lead the team in 3-point shooting. Stephani has made a team-high 36 3-pointers, and Fisher (42.5 percent) and Peterson (41.7 percent) are tops in percentage.

►Fisher came off the bench for just the second time this season in the game at Beloit, and he responded with a career-high 18 points. Fisher hit 5-of-7 shots from the floor, including 3-of-4 from 3-point range.

►Senior forward Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) leads the team and ranks third in the Midwest Conference at 7.3 rebounds per game. Willer is also averaging double figures in points at 12.1 per game.

►Lawrence is second in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 72.6 points per game. The Vikings are ninth in scoring at 69.3.

►Lawrence ranks second in the Midwest Conference in field goal percentage defense at 39.8 percent. The Vikings are shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, good for fourth in the conference.

►Lawrence is shooting 34.9 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks fifth in the conference. The Vikings are second in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 32.5 percent.

SCOUTING ST. NORBERT

►The Green Knights saw their epic 72-game Midwest Conference winning streak snapped with an 81-55 loss at Ripon last Wednesday. It is believed to be the longest conference winning streak in NCAA Division III history.



►St. Norbert got back to its winning ways with a 65-48 victory over visiting Knox this past Saturday. None of the St. Norbert starters scored in double figures, but Mitchell Reinthaler came off the bench to pour in 17 points on 7-for-9 shooting.

►Last week's loss dropped St. Norbert to 13th in the latest D3hoops.com Top 25. The Green Knights were ranked seventh in the previous poll.

►Junior guard D.J. DeValk paces the Green Knights in scoring at 15.5 points per game while shooting 42.1

percent from the floor. DeValk also has drained a team-best 37 3-pointers this season and is shooting 37.4 percent from beyond the arc.

▶DeValk also is averaging 4.5 assists per game, which ranks second in the Midwest Conference.

▶Ben Bobinski also is averaging double figures in points at 12.2 per game, and Terrence Garner is tops on the squad at 6.7 rebounds per game.

▶St. Norbert is the top defensive team in all of NCAA Division III and allows just 55.5 points per game. The Green Knights are eighth in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 70.3 points per contest.

▶St. Norbert leads the Midwest Conference and ranks ninth nationally in field goal percentage defense at 38.3 percent. The Green Knights are shooting 45.3 percent, good for fifth in the league.

▶St. Norbert is tops in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 31.5 percent. The Green Knights are seventh in the conference in 3-point shooting at 32.9 percent.

SCOUTING GRINNELL

▶After losing four of its last five, Grinnell posted a huge win with a 104-101 victory over Ripon this past Saturday. Vinny Curta scored 35 for the Pioneers in the victory, and Grinnell limited All-American Ty Sabin to 25 points.



▶Grinnell travels to Cornell on Wednesday before the Pioneers host Lawrence on Saturday.

▶The Pioneers' high-scoring offense has three players averaging double figures in points. Vinny Curta is tops on the team at 25.5 points per game. Julian Marx is second on the team at 22.9 points per contest, and Ky-Sean Johnson is at 14.7.

▶Marx is the top 3-point shooter on the squad and has hit 77 on the season. He's shooting 41 percent from beyond the arc.

▶The Pioneers hit the offensive glass hard and have almost as many offensive rebounds (259) as defensive rebounds (285).

▶Grinnell ranks second in NCAA Division III in scoring at 114.3 points per game. The Pioneers are giving up 110.7 points per contest.

▶Teams are shooting a league-best 62.5 percent against Grinnell. The Pioneers are shooting 42.6 percent from the floor, good for eighth in the conference.

▶Grinnell ranks fourth in the league in 3-point shooting at 35.5 percent. The Pioneers are eighth in the conference in defending the 3-pointer at 37.7 percent.
