**THE COACHES**

▶Joel DePagter (Lawrence 1998), the 1997 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and 2009 Midwest Confer-

ence Coach of the Year, is in his 10th season at Lawrence and has a record of 126-105 (.545).

▶Ryan Kane (St. Norbert 1999) is in his fifth season at Ripon and has a record of 64-43 (.598).

▶Ken Davis (Arizona State) is in his third season at Lake Forest and has a record of 34-32 (.515).

**THE SERIES**

▶In a series that goes all the way back to 1906, Ripon holds a 139-81 edge over the Vikings. Ripon has won nine straight, but prior to that, Lawrence had taken 14 of the previous 21.

▶Lawrence holds a 58-51 advantage over Lake Forest in a series that dates back to 1915. The Vikings are 9-9 against the Foresters during Joel DePagter's tenure as head coach.

## LAST GAME

It was a must-win game Saturday for Lawrence, and the Vikings pulled out a gritty 68-65 Midwest Conference victory over Monmouth at Alexander Gymnasium.

The Vikings held off the Scots with some critical defensive stops and contributions large and small from a multitude of players. Lawrence is tied with Lake Forest College for third place in the league standings with both teams one game ahead of Cornell College as all three fight for the remaining two MWC Tournament berths.

Jeremy Stephani and Ben Peterson paced Lawrence with 13 points apiece, and Stephani handed out a game-high six assists. Eric Weiss and Mitch Willer added 10 points apiece for the Vikings, and Willer grabbed a team-best seven rebounds.

Lamont Mitchell led Monmouth with 21 points and 10 rebounds, and Monmouth's Justin Aluya added 20 points before fouling out.

Lawrence built a 13-point edge at 41-28 early in the second half, but the Scots chipped away and tied it at 53-53 with 6:15 remaining. It would remain tight the rest of the way, but Lawrence never gave up the lead.

The Vikings built the lead back to four as Connor Weas hit a 3-pointer and then drained two free throws for a 61-57 advantage. The Scots trimmed the margin to 62-60 on a pair of Mitchell free throws with 2:55 remaining.

Lawrence then got three consecutive defensive stops, including one when freshman Tyler Klug drew a key offensive foul against Aluya, who fouled out of the game with 1:51 left.

After Paul Engo made a free throw to trim the lead to 62-61 with 1:07 left, Weiss came up with a huge driving layup to give the Vikings a 64-61 lead with 54 seconds left.

A pair of Mitchell free throws cut Lawrence's lead to 64-63, and Weiss was fouled with 28 seconds left. He made both free throws, but Mitchell answered with a layup for the Scots. Weas was then fouled with 14 seconds left and made both free throws

clinched spots in the four-team event.

►Lawrence controls its own destiny because it would be the third seed in the MWC Tournament by winning its final two games. The Vikings have the toughest games as they play two of the top three teams in the conference. Cornell has the easiest games remaining as it plays at Beloit and Monmouth.

►Junior guard Jeremy Stephani (Arlington Heights, Ill./Wheeling) ran his streak of scoring in double figures to nine games with 13 points against Monmouth. Stephani leads the team in scoring at 13.8 points per game.

►Two other Vikings, junior Ben Peterson (River Forest, Ill./Fenwick) and senior Mitch Willer (Sussex, Wis./Sussex Hamilton) are also scoring in double figures. Peterson is at 11.1 points per game and Willer is at 10.9. Willer also is averaging a team-best 6.6 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game.

►Stephani and Peterson are the team leaders in 3-point shooting. Stephani has made a team-high 49 3-pointers this season, and Peterson has 47 while shooting a team-best 42.3 percent (47-111) from beyond the arc.

►Junior guard Eric Weiss (Birmingham, Mich./Bloomfield Hills) turned in perhaps his best game of the season against Monmouth. He scored 10 points, was 2-for-2 on 3-pointers and scored four of Lawrence's final six points to help seal the victory.

►Lawrence is sixth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 75.5 points per game. The Vikings are eighth in scoring at 69.8.

►Lawrence ranks second in the conference in field goal percentage defense at 40.7 percent. The Vikings are shooting 46 percent from the floor, good for fifth in the conference.

►Lawrence is shooting 35.7 percent

**SCOUTING RIPON**



►Ripon has clinched a berth in the MWC Tournament, but the Red Hawks now have an outside shot to host the tournament. Ripon is one game behind St. Norbert, but the Green Knights have a pair of home games to finish the regular season. Ripon is coming off a 73-62 win at Illinois College on Saturday.

►Senior guard Ty Sabin leads all of NCAA Division III in scoring at 29.9 points per game and is coming off a 35-point performance at Illinois College. Sabin is shooting 56 percent from the floor and 46.7 percent from 3-point range. The versatile Sabin also leads the team in rebounding at 6.0 per game and has team highs with 60 assists and 30 steals.

▶Sabin has 2,388 for his career and just passed Grinnell's Steve Wood for second place in Midwest Conference history. The leader is Grinnell's John Grotberg at 2,848.

▶Ripon is second in the league in scoring at 82.1 points per game, and the Red Hawks are third in scoring defense at 72.

▶Ripon leads the league in shooting at 51.4 percent, and the Red Hawks are third in field goal percentage defense at 40.9 percent.

▶Ripon ranks first in the MWC in 3-point shooting at 44.6 percent. Ripon is fourth in defending the 3-pointer at 34 percent.

## SCOUTING LAKE FOREST

▶Lake Forest has lost two straight, including a 66-63 setback to Cornell, and must play at St. Norbert before hosting Lawrence on Saturday.

▶Lake Forest's balanced attack is led by Eric Porter, who is averaging 13.6 points per game. Danny Sotos is at 13.2 and Jim Schick is at 11.9. Schick leads the conference in rebounding at 9.1 per contest.

▶Porter has drained a team-best 57 3-pointers this season and is shooting 39.6 percent from beyond the arc.

▶Lake Forest is second in the conference in scoring defense at 70.9 points per game. The Foresters are fourth in scoring at 73.7.

▶Lake Forest is fourth in the league in shooting at 46.7 percent, and the Foresters rank fifth in field goal percentage defense at 43 percent.

▶Lake Forest is fifth in the conference in 3-point shooting at 35.2 percent and seventh in defending the 3-pointer at 36.3 percent.
