# Lawrence University BOYS BASKETBALL CAMP



### Head Coach Joel DePagter – Camp Supervisor

Coach Joel DePagter just completed his fourth season as head coach of the Lawrence University men's basketball team. DePagter has already guided the Vikings to 2 Midwest Conference Championships and 2 NCAA National Tournament appearances. Since his arrival in 2003, the Vikings have played in the NCAA Division III National Tournament 5 times. During DePagter's 4 years as an assistant coach, the Lawrence Men's Basketball team had an overall record of 82-22, including three consecutive conference championships, a 2004 Elite 8 appearance, and a #1 national ranking in 05-06. A 1998 graduate of Lawrence, "JoJo" led the Vikings to a 22-3 record, a 1997 Midwest Conference Championship and the school's first-ever NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. DePagter is the only man in the history of the Midwest Conference to be named Player of the Year (1997) and Coach of the Year (2008-09). He holds the career records in assists and steals, and currently stands 8th on the all-time scoring list. DePagter was inducted to the Lawrence Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

### Chris Kellett (Assistant Coach, Lawrence University) - Camp Director

Kellett just finished his first season on the Lawrence Men's Basketball Coaching Staff. Prior to his arrival at Lawrence, Kellett enjoyed a standout playing career at Concordia University (WI) and Ripon College and was a coach at Neenah High School. Kellett is also currently the head coach of the Wisconsin Blizzard's top AAU 17-U basketball program. Kellett began his college basketball career at Concordia University (WI) and as a freshman led them to their first conference championship in over 10 years. He was named the Defensive Player of the Year twice at Ripon and averaged over 16 points/game his senior season. Kellett, a Neenah native, was a standout in football, basketball, and track at Neenah High School - earning All-conference honors in both basketball and football and playing in the state All-Star games for each sport as well. Kellett graduated from Ripon College with a degree in Elementary Education and Psychology. Kellett and his fiancée, Kate, live in Neenah.

### Lee Rabas (Head Coach: UW-Fox Valley) – Special Camp Assistant

Lee Rabas just finished his 2<sup>nd</sup> year as head coach at UW-Fox Valley this after serving for 5 years as an assistant coach with the Lawrence University Vikings, and is in his 21<sup>st</sup> year of basketball coaching overall. In his first year, the Cyclones went 22-6 and Rabas was named the Eastern Division Coach of the Year. Rabas was the head boys' basketball coach at Appleton Xavier High School for seven years putting together an overall record of 103-56. He was named the *Appleton Post-Crescent* All-Area Coach of the Year in 1998 guiding Xavier to a runner-up finish at the 1998 WISAA State Tournament. His Xavier teams won conference championships in 2002 and 2003. Rabas also works as a physical education instructor at Clayton Elementary School in Neenah, and serves on the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association Executive Board.
