Joel DePagter Camp director

Joel DePagter became Lawrence University's head basketball coach in 2007. He already has collected the fourth most wins in the 104-year history of Lawrence basketball. He guided the Vikings to back-to-back Midwest Conference Championships and NCAA Division III National Tournaments in both 2008 and 2009. In 2009, after Lawrence's fifth title in six years, DePagter was named the Midwest Conference Coach of the Year, becoming the first man in the history of the Midwest Conference to be named MWC Player of the Year (1997) and MWC Coach of the Year (2009). As a player at Lawrence, DePagter was a three-time first team All-MWC selection and stands eighth on the all-time scoring list with 1,243 points. He also holds the career record for assists and steals. He was inducted into the Lawrence University Athletic Hall of Fame for his playing career in the fall of 2008.



Lee Rabas Assistant camp director

Lee Rabas became the head coach of the UW-Fox Valley Men's Basketball team last fall after being an assistant at Lawrence University for five seasons. Prior to Lawrence, Rabas was the head coach at Appleton Xavier High School for seven seasons winning two conference championships, and was named the 1998 *Post-Crescent* Coach of the Year. Coach Rabas also serves on the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association executive board. He earned his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse.
