Joel DePagter is finishing his first year as head coach at Lawrence University after serving as the assistant coach since 2003. Since DePagter's arrival at Lawrence, the men's basketball team has won three conference championships, a 2004 Elite 8 appearance, and a #1 national ranking in 2006. A 1998 graduate of Lawrence, DePagter led the Vikings to a 22-3 record, a 1997 Midwest Conference Championship, and the school's first-ever NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. He was named the 1997 conference Player of the Year and holds career records in assists and steals, while currently standing seventh on the all-time scoring list.

Lee Rabas, Assistant Camp Director

Lee Rabas is finishing his fourth year as an assistant with the Lawrence University men's basketball program. Rabas was the head coach at Appleton Xavier High School for seven seasons with an overall record of 103-56.
