

VIKINGS UPDATE

The Vikings open their season looking for their first victory in a season opener since Lawrence defeated Clarkson (N.Y.) 73-45 back on Nov. 16, 2007. The Vikings



have dropped six consecutive season openers.

Lawrence has a record of 16-22 in season openers. The Vikings won their first seven season openers starting with a 40-9 victory over Marantha Baptist back in 1975 in the first game ever for the Vikings.

The Vikings lost two players to graduation that reside among the top 25 scorers in school history. Guard Alex Deshler finished ninth in Lawrence history with 909 career points and ranks fifth with 604 rebounds. Deshler is one of only three players with more than 900 points and 600 rebounds. The other two are Lawrence Hall of

Famer Gina Seegers and Felice Porrata. Amber Lisowe graduated with 598 points despite playing only two seasons. She missed her rookie season and played just a few minutes of her senior season due to injuries.

The Vikings do return a number of experienced players in starters Andrea Wilkinson (Racine, Wis./Lutheran) and Kassidy Rinehart 🚪 (Hortonville, Hortonville). Wilkin-

son averaged 7.8 points and 4.7 rebounds per game last season, and Rinehart was at 6.8 points and 4.6 rebounds per contest. Wilkinson shot a Kassidy Rinehart



team-best 40.3 per-

cent from the floor, and Rinehart led the team with 2.2 assists per game last season.

The Vikings are still awaiting the return of two more requlars from last season. Guard Patsy Kealey (New Rochelle, N.Y./ Ursuline) is coming back from injury, Patsy Kealey and forward Katie Schumacher (Little Chute, Wis./Little Chute) is studying abroad during the first term. Kealey averaged 6.5 points per game last season





and picked up 4.8 re- Katie Schumacher

bounds per contest. Schumacher averaged a team-best 5.7 rebounds per game last season to go along with 6.7 points per game.

Lawrence got an influx of new players for the upcoming season. Seven new faces joined the team for 2014-15, and that gives the Vikings, who

have struggled with numbers over the past few seasons, 14 players on the roster. This is the largest team since the Vikings had 20 players on the squad during Amy Proctor's last season as head coach in 2006-07.

Lawrence was picked to finish last in the Midwest Conference in a preseason poll of league coaches. The Vikings won just one game in conference play a season ago. St. Norbert was picked to win the conference with Cornell chosen to finish second.

Former player Cathy Kaye, a softball and basketball standout for the Vikings, has joined the squad as an assistant coach this season.

Lawrence finished last in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense last season at 50.5 points per game. The Vikings were seventh in scoring defense at 67.7 points per contest.

Lawrence shot just 33.8 percent from the floor last season, which ranked last in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings were seventh in field goal percentage defense at 40.3 percent.

The Vikings hit on 18.9 percent of their 3-pointers last season, which was last in the Midwest Conference. Lawrence was eighth in 3-point defense at 29.0 percent.

SCOUTING CONCORDIA

► Concordia Chicago endured a difficult season in 2013-14 as the Cougars finished with a 2-23 record.



Concordia went 2-18 in the Northern Athletics Conference to finish 11th among the 12 teams in the league.

Concordia earned its two wins last season in back-to-back contests against Rockford and Benedictine (III.) late in the season.

Concordia lost top scorer April Broska to graduation after she averaged 12.4 points per game in 2013-14.

Forward Angelik Young is the top returning scorer for Concordia after she averaged 8.4 points per game last season. Young also was the top rebounder on the squad last season at 6.9 per contest.

Look for guard Morgan Jahnke to direct the Concordia offense. She averaged a team-best 2.9 assists per game in 2013-14.
