►Tamlyn Tills (UW-La Crosse 1982) is in her eighth season at Lake Forest and has a record of 83-81 (.506). She is in her 21st season overall and has a record of 219-288 (.432).

THE SERIES

►Ripon has a 51-28 advantage in the series that goes back to the 1975-76 season. The Red Hawks have won

16 straight, including a pair of close games last season.

▶Lake Forest holds a 47-13 edge in a series that dates back to the 1975-76 season. The Foresters have won 16 consecutive games against the Vikings.

LAST GAME

Lawrence struggled out of the gate and Marian posted a 57-28 non-conference victory on Tuesday in the season opener at Sadoff Gymnasium.

Marian bolted to a 25-7 lead after the first quarter, and the Sabres led 36-10 at the half.

Nicole Paulus led Marian and all scorers with 19 points, and Brittany Bauman added 11.

Andrea Wilkinson led Lawrence with eight points and pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds to go along with three steals. The Vikings hit on only 10-of-48 shots from the floor (20.8 percent), and Lawrence shot just 2-of-13 (15.4 percent) from beyond the arc.

Marian opened the second half by scoring 11 consecutive points to push the lead to 47-10 and never led by less than 27 points the rest of the way.

VIKINGS UPDATE

▶The Vikings will need to rebound in a big way following a setback in the season opener at Marian on Tuesday.



Lawrence had a rough night shooting the ball all the way around. The Vikings hit just 20.4 percent from the floor (10-49), including 14.3 percent from on 3-pointers (2-14).

▶Three players made their Lawrence debut on Tuesday night as Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./East), Sammi Jo Nixon (Wadsworth, Ill./Warren Township) and Leah Reeves (Lisle, Ill./Lisle) all saw action. Scott, the junior transfer from UW-La Crosse, was a starter, and Nixon and Reeves both came off the bench. Reeves had the best de-

but with four points and seven rebounds in just 11 minutes of action.

▶Senior forward Andrea Wilkinson (Racine, Wis./Lu-

theran) pulled down a game-high 11 rebounds against Marian. That was just two rebounds shy of Wilkinson's career high. She grabbed 13 boards at Finlandia in December 2013.

▶The Vikings held their own on the boards against Marian and were out-rebounded by just two (40-38). Lawrence did grab 14 offensive rebounds, including four by senior Patsy Kealey (New Rochelle, N.Y./Ursuline).

▶The Vikings will be without head coach Ashley Wellman for at least the next two games. Wellman was scheduled to have her first child on Wednesday but had not given birth yet on Thursday.

SCOUTING RIPON

▶Ripon got its season off to a great start with a 52-51 win at UW-Platteville on Nov. 17.



Laurissa Johnson hit a jumper with 16 seconds left to give Ripon a one-point lead. The Pioneers missed a jumper at the buzzer that would have won it. Ripon led 14-4 after the first quarter, and the Red Hawks had to hold off Platteville, which outscored Ripon 25-16 in the final period.

▶The victory over UW-Platteville was Ripon's first win in a season opener in five seasons.

▶Freshman center Maggie Oimoen had a big game in her collegiate debut. She scored 16 points and grabbed six rebounds in the win over UW-Platteville.

▶Ripon returns four starters, including their top three scorers from a year ago. Sophomore Emma McDonald is back after leading the team in scoring last season at 8.5 points per game. Junior Nicole Herkert is back and was Ripon's top rebounder a season ago. She was eighth in the Midwest Conference at 6.6 rebounds per game in

2014-15.

▶Ripon finished 10th in the Midwest Conference last season in scoring at 49.0 points per game. The Red Hawks were sixth in the league in scoring defense at 63.0 points per contest.

▶Ripon shot 32.8 percent from the floor last season, and that ranked last in the league. Ripon was ninth in field goal percentage defense at 41.7 percent.

▶Ripon hit on 26.9 percent of its 3-pointers, which was seventh in the league. Ripon ranked 10th in defending the 3-pointer at 31.7 percent.

SCOUTING LAKE FOREST

▶Lake Forest opened its season with a 56-46 loss at the University of Chicago back on



Nov. 14. Michelle Ricolcol scored 14 points and K.C. Stralka grabbed 13 rebounds to pace the Foresters. Chicago pulled away in the second half by limiting Lake Forest to just 18 points, including eight in the third quarter.

▶Lake Forest opens Midwest Conference play by hosting Cornell on Saturday before traveling to Lawrence on the day before Thanksgiving.

▶Senior guard Michelle Ricolcol leads the Foresters into the season after earning second-team All-Midwest Conference honors a year ago. Ricolcol averaged 9.3 points per game while shooting 45.1 percent from the floor.

▶The Foresters were one of the better defensive teams in the league last season. Lake Forest ranked fifth in the league in scoring defense at 62.2 points per game. Lake Forest was third in the league in field goal percentage defense at 34.9 percent. The Foresters ranked third in defending the 3-pointer at 27.2 percent.

▶Lake Forest was ninth in the conference in scoring a season ago at 58.0 points per game. The Foresters shot 38.6 percent from the floor, which was good for eighth in the league. Lake Forest shot 28.9 percent from 3-point range, and that ranked fifth in the conference.

Marian bolted to a 25-7 lead after the first quarter, and the Sabres led 36-10 at the half.

Nicole Paulus led Marian and all scorers with 19 points, and Brittany Bauman added 11.

Andrea Wilkinson led Lawrence with eight points and pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds to go along with three steals. The Vikings hit on only 10-of-48 shots from the floor (20.8 percent), and Lawrence shot just 2-of-13 (15.4 percent) from beyond the arc.

Marian opened the second half by scoring 11 consecutive points to push the lead to 47-10 and never led by less than 27 points the rest of the way.
