Monmouth holds a 20-11 lead in a series that started in the 1988-89 season. The Scots have won the last 16 meetings, and Lawrence's last wins came courtesy of a season sweep during the 2006-07 campaign.

LAST GAME

A big second quarter Monday pushed Knox to a 75-57 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence at Alexander Gymnasium.

Knox outscored the Vikings 19-2 over the final 7:32 of the second quarter to turn around a close game. The Prairie Fire led 42-24 at the half.

Jarrelyn McCall led Knox with a double-double of 13 points and 10 rebounds. Knox had a balanced attack with three players in double figures and six players with at least nine points.

Aubrey Scott led three Lawrence players in double figures with 12 points, and she added six rebounds. Leah Reeves added 11 points and seven rebounds for the Vikings, and

Olivia Hoesley had 10 points and nine rebounds. Shonell Benjamin grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds for the Vikinas.

The Vikings trailed 23-17 after the opening period, but Reeves got a layup and Scott buried a 3-pointer to cut Knox's lead to 23-22 with 8:14 left in the second guarter. Knox then hit four 3-pointers, sandwiched around a layup, to pull out to a 37-24 edge.

The Vikings opened the second half with a 3-pointer from Nicole Cummins and Hoesley jumper to cut the lead to 42-29. Knox immediately stretched the lead back to 47-29, but the Vikings scored six straight points, capped by Lauren Deveikis' jumper, to cut the margin to 47-35.

Knox then put the Vikings away by scoring the final 10 points of the third guarter with Karlie Thorn's 3-pointer giving the Prairie Fire a 57-35 lead after three. Lawrence didn't get closer than 18 points in the fourth quarter.

VIKINGS UPDATE

▶Sophomore forward Leah Reeves (Lisle, III./ Lisle) has really turned up her offensive game in the last four games. Reeves is averaging 15.3

over her last three contests. Scott has made a team-high 11 3-pointers and is the team's top 3-point shooter at 33.3 percent (11-33). Scott is now averaging 7.3 points and 3.5 rebounds per contest.

Junior guard Nicole Cummins (San Antonio, Texas/John Marshall) picked up three more assists against Knox to push her season total to a team-best 29. Cum- Nicole Cummins mins, who is averag-



ing 5.1 points per game, ranks sixth in the Midwest Conference at 2.9 assists per game.

The Vikings rank ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 69.3 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in scoring at 47.7 points per game.

Lawrence is fifth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 36.9 percent. Lawrence is hitting 31.2 percent of its shots from the floor, and that ranks 10th in the conference.

The Vikings are second in the Midwest Conference in defending the 3-pointer at 24.9 percent. Lawrence is 10th in the conference in 3-point shooting but the Vikings' percentage has climbed to 23.5 percent.





SCOUTING MONMOUTH

Monmouth has dropped four in a row, and the Scots face visit-



ing Lake Forest in a Midwest Conference game on Wednesday before hosting the Vikings on Saturday.

Monmouth's lone victory on the season is a 65-60 win over visiting Beloit on Dec. 3.

►It's a new era for Monmouth with rookie head coach Kyle Wilson. He was an assistant coach at a pair of NCAA Division III schools before taking over at Monmouth. Wilson is a 2005 graduate of Hanover.

▶ Rookie guard Rebecca Gallis is leading the team in scoring at 12.8 points per game while shooting 35.2 percent from the floor. Junior guard Keri Dodson also is in double figures at 11.0 points per game and is shooting 40.4 percent from the field.

Maddie Dohleman is tops on the squad at 6.3 rebounds per game to go with 8.2 points per contest.

Monmouth is sixth in the league in scoring at 58.9 points per game. The Scots are last in scoring defense at 77.8 points per contest.

Monmouth is shooting a solid 38.7 percent from the floor, good for sixth in the conference. The Scots are last in field goal percentage defense at 46.7 percent.

Monmouth is the top 3-point shooting team in the conference at 36.3 percent. Gallis leads the team at 41.1 percent and has hit a team-high 23 3-pointers. The Scots are last in the conference in defending the 3-pointer at 41.0 percent.
