## **THE COACHES**

Ashley Wellman (Alma 2008) is in her third season at Lawrence and has a record of 4-65 (.058).

►Clayton Morrison (Maranatha Baptist 1987) is in his 24th Ashley Wellman



season at Maranatha

Baptist and has a record of 261-374 (.411).

Lyndsey Seewald (Carroll 2011) is in her first season at Marian.

#### **THE SERIES**

In a series that stretches back to 1975, Lawrence holds a 16-1 advantage over Maranatha Baptist. The teams haven't played since late in the 2014-15 season, and the Vikings downed Maranatha 73-39 in that contest at Alexander Gymnasium.

In a series that started in the 1975-76 season, Lawrence has a 27-24 advantage over Marian. The Sabres have won the last six meetings, including a 57-28 victory at Marian early in the 2015-16 season.

### **LAST GAME**

Kelsey Walsberg scored 33 points and hit a school-record 10 3-pointers to lead Monmouth to a 77-66 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Feb. 20, 2016.

Walsberg went 10-for-21 from beyond the arc for the Scots.

Andrea Wilkinson led four Vikings in double figures with 16 points. Patsy Kealey and Natalie Kramer scored 13 points apiece Lawrence, and Liz Arco had a double-double with 10 points and a game-high 10 rebounds.

The Scots went on a 9-1 run over the final 2:15 of the second quarter to grab a 32-23 lead at the half. Monmouth then withstood a pair of second-half runs by the Vikings.

Monmouth led by as many as 13 points in the third quarter, but the Vikings sliced into that advantage late in the third and early in the fourth. Jumpers by Kealey and Arco and a 3-pointer from Kramer trimmed the Monmouth lead to 52-46 with 8:58 left in the game.

The Vikings got as close as 54-49 after Olivia Hoesley buried a 3-pointer, but the Scots responded and pushed the lead to 68-53.

Lawrence chipped away at the lead and went on a 10-3 run, capped by a pair of Wilkinson free throws, to trim the margin to 71-63 with 1:18 left.

Walsberg then hit back-to-back 3-pointers to snuff out any potential comeback.

## **VIKINGS UPDATE**

▶The Vikings enter the season with six players returning from a season ago, including starters Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./East), Natalie Kram-



er (Mendota Heights, Minn./Henry Sibley) and Olivia Hoesley (Eau Claire,

Wis./North). Lawrence also welcomes four new players to the mix.

▶The Vikings' top returning scorer is Scott, who averaged 4.4 points and 3.1 re- Aubrey Scott



bounds per game a season ago. Hoesley was at 4.3 points and 1.5 rebounds last season. Hoesley also made a team-best 21 3-pointers last season while shooting Olivia Hoesley 25.3 percent from beyond the arc.



▶Sophomore forward Leah Reeves (Lisle, III./Lisle) will see her role expand greatly this season as the tallest player on the squad. Reeves averaged 2.0 points and 2.7 rebounds per game while playing 11.8 minutes per contest. She also shot a solid 42.6 percent from the floor.

▶The Vikings ranked 11th in the Midwest Conference in scoring last season at 47.0 points per game. Lawrence finished eighth in scoring defense at 70.6.

Lawrence shot 33.0 percent from the floor, which ranked 11th in the conference in 2015-16. The Vikings ranked seventh in field goal percentage defense at 41.4.

▶The Vikings shot 23.6 percent from beyond the 3-point line, and that ranked 11th in the conference a season ago. Lawrence ranked 10th in defending the 3-pointer at 32.3 percent.

Lawrence ranked 11th in the conference in free-throw shooting at 60.8 percent.

▶The Vikings were 11th in the league in rebounding margin at minus-9.0.

#### **SCOUTING MARANATHA**

**▶** Maranatha **Baptist** went 10-12 a season ago while playing an independent schedule. The Sabercats are members of NCAA Division III but also



compete as part of the NCCAA, the National Christian College Athletic Association.

- Maranatha, which is a school of 1,300 students located in Watertown, Wis., has one of the longest-tenured coaches in Wisconsin in Clayton Morrison. He is entering his 24th season in Watertown.
- Maranatha lost its top player to graduation in Emily Hinsenkamp. She averaged an impressive double-double last season at 16.7 points and 12.3 rebounds per game.
- The top returning scorers for the Sabercats are junior Alexis Johnson and senior Hanna Glaze. Johnson averaged 10.6 points and 7.1 rebounds last season while Glaze was at 10.3 points and 5.5 rebounds per game.
- ▶The Sabercats averaged 58.0 points per game while shooting 35.7 percent from the floor, including 21.8 percent from beyond the arc. Maranatha shot a solid 65.2 percent from the foul line.

## **SCOUTING MARIAN**

It's a new era for Marian as Lyndsey Seewald takes over the Sabres' head coach. Seewald



takes over for Bill Peters, who coached Marian for six seasons and compiled a record of 57-96. Seewald should be a familiar face to Lawrence fans as she was a standout at Carroll, now a former member of the Midwest Conference. Seewald coached at the two-year campus at UW-Waukesha for one season before being named the Marian coach last April.

- Marian finished 6-19 a season ago and were tabbed to finish 10th in the 12-team Northern Athletics Conference this season.
- ▶The Sabres return their top player from a season ago in senior guard Nicole Paulus. She averaged 11.9 points and 3.2 rebounds per game a season ago while shooting 35 percent from

the floor. Paulus also is the team's top returning 3-point shooter after hitting 63 treys while shooting 36.6 percent from beyond the arc.

- ▶The Sabres are in the same boat as the Vikings without great depth this season. Marian has just 11 players listed on its roster for 2016-17.
- Marian averaged 54.8 points per game last season while shooting 34.6 percent from the floor, including 29.6 percent from 3-point range. The Sabres shot 68.5 percent from the foul line last season.
