THE SERIES

►The Cornell series, which started in the 1988-89 season, is tied 7-7. Lawrence put together a seven-game win streak against the Rams from 1989-06, and Cornell has won the last six meetings.

►Illinois College has a 21-18 lead in a

series that started in the 1991-92 season. The Lady Blues have won the last seven meetings.

LAST GAME

Monmouth pulled away in the final five minutes last Saturday and went on to a 72-57 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence at Glennie Gymnasium.

Leah Reeves scored 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds to pace Lawrence. Olivia Hoesley added 13 points, and Lauren Deveikis had nine points and a team-best four assists for the Vikings.

Maddie Dohleman scored 16 points to lead three Monmouth players in double figures.

Lawrence trailed by double digits at 53-42 with two minutes left in the third quarter but the Vikings rallied. Lawrence went on an 8-2 run, capped by Deveikis' layup, to trim the margin to 55-50 with 7:09 remaining.

The teams traded baskets before Izy Todd hit her second consecutive 3-pointer to trigger a 9-0 outburst that gave Monmouth a 67-52 advantage with 1:58 remaining.

Aubrey Scott, who finished with eight points and seven rebounds, then hit a 3-pointer for Lawrence to finally stop the run. Hoesley followed with a jumper to cut the lead to 67-57 but that's as close as the Vikings would get.

Monmouth went 5-for-6 from the line in the final minute to seal the win.

The Scots led the entire game but didn't pull away from Lawrence until the final minutes. Monmouth led by as many as six points in the opening quarter but back-to-back 3-pointers from Scott and Deveikis helped cut the margin to 18-16 after one quarter.

Monmouth went up 24-16 early in the second quarter, but the Vikings scored seven consecutive points, including five from Hoesley, to cut the lead to 24-23. The Scots went back up by six, but Shonell Benajmin's jumper in the final seconds of the second quarter trimmed Monmouth's lead to 35-33 at the half.

VIKINGS UPDATE

►Sophomore forward Leah Reeves (Lisle, Ill./Lisle) ran her streak of scoring in double figures to three games and four of the last five with 14 points at Monmouth last Saturday. In her last five games, Reeves is averaging 15 points and 6.2 rebounds per game while shooting 43.7 percent from the floor. On the season, Reeves leads the team in scoring at 10.5 points and rebounding at 6.0 per game.



►Junior guard Olivia Hoesley (Eau Claire, Wis./North) also has averaged double figures in points over the past

five games at 10.6 per game. Hoesley also is pulling down a strong 6.2 rebounds per game in that stretch.

►Senior guard Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./East) is shooting 41.7 percent (10-24) from beyond the arc over the past five games. Scott, who is shooting 35.1 percent on 3-pointers this season, has improved to 7.4 points per game.

►Junior guard Lauren Deveikis (Naperville, Ill./Neuqua Valley) had her best all-around game of the season at Monmouth with season highs of nine points and four assists to go with three rebounds.

►The Vikings rank ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 69.5 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in scoring at 48.5 points per game.

►Lawrence is sixth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 38.0 percent. Lawrence is hitting 31.7 percent of its shots from the floor, and that ranks 10th in the conference.

►The Vikings are second in the Midwest Conference in defending the 3-pointer at 25.9 percent. Lawrence is 10th in the conference in 3-point shooting but the Vikings' percentage has climbed to 24.6 percent.

SCOUTING CORNELL

►Cornell remained unbeaten in the league with a 56-53 overtime victory at Knox this past Saturday. Knox tied it with jumper with 14 seconds left in regulation, but four turnovers in overtime doomed the Prairie Fire. Cornell went 4-for-4 from the foul line in the



final 27 seconds to seal the victory.

▶Diamond Boyd and Sierra Bisso provide the 1-2 scoring punch for Cornell. Boyd is averaging a double-double of 15.2 points per game while shooting 48.6 percent from the floor and 10.9 rebounds per contest. Bisso is at 14.5 points per contest and has made a team-best 33 3-pointers this season while shooting 37.1 percent from beyond the arc.

▶Guard Haley Grana is tops on the squad at 2.9 assists per contest.

▶Cornell is fourth in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 63.2 points per game. The Rams are second in scoring defense at 54.2 points per contest.

▶Cornell is shooting 37.4 percent from the floor, good for seventh in the conference. The Rams are third in field goal percentage defense at 34.8 percent.

▶The Rams are shooting 33 percent from beyond the arc, and that ranks third in the conference. Cornell is fourth in 3-point defense at 28.8 percent.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS COLLEGE

▶Illinois College's only Midwest Conference loss this season was a 16-point defeat at Cornell, but the Lady Blues bounced back to beat Beloit 56-41 last Saturday and have won six of their last seven.

▶Super sophomore Brielle Greenleaf is leading Illinois College and the Midwest Conference in scoring at 17.3 points per game. Greenleaf, who is shooting 48.8 percent from the floor, is averaging 4.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game.

▶Carly Cameron is fourth in the league in scoring 14.9 per game while shooting 47.1 percent from the floor. Cameron ranks second in the conference



at 8.1 rebounds per game.

▶Illinois College is second in the conference in scoring at 67.6 points per game. The Lady Blues are fourth in scoring defense at 57.5 points per contest.

▶Illinois College is shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, good for third in the league. The Lady Blues are fourth in field goal percentage defense at 35.6 percent.

▶The Lady Blues are shooting 29.7 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks fifth in the conference. Illinois College is eighth in defending the 3-pointer at 31.1 percent.
