THE COACHES

Ashley Wellman (Alma 2008) is in her fourth season at Lawrence and has a

record of 6-76 (.073). Tamlyn Tills (UW-La Crosse 1982) is in her ninth season at Lake Forest and has a record of 97-102 (.487). She is in her 22nd season overall Ashlev Wellman and has a record of 233-309 (.430).



Gloria Bradley (Seton Hall 1984) is in her first season at Beloit and has a record of 2-11 (.154). She is in her 19th season overall and has a record of 242-252 (.490).

THE SERIES

Lake Forest leads the series, which started in the 1975-76 season, 49-13 over Lawrence. The Foresters have won 18 consecutive meetings against the Vikings.

Beloit leads the series 36-28 and has won the last 16 meetings with Lawrence. Prior to the current streak by Beloit, the Vikings had won six straight and 16 of 18.

LAST GAME

A second-guarter run last Saturday staked Illinois College to a double-digit lead, and the Lady Blues went on to an 83-44 Midwest Conference win over Lawrence at Alexander Gymnasium.

Illinois College finished the first half on a 16-5 run to grab a 47-30 at the break and pulled away from there.

Carly Cameron led Illinois College with 14 points.

Leah Reeves paced the Vikings with 12 points, and she pulled down seven rebounds. Olivia Hoesley added 11 points for Lawrence, and Aubrey Scott grabbed a game-high eight rebounds.

The Lady Blues built a 13-point lead at 29-16 late in the first quarter when Lawrence rallied. Scott hit a jumper at the first-quarter buzzer, and Hoesley opened the second quarter with a 3-pointer to trim the lead to 29-21.

Lawrence's Nicole Cummins and Cameron traded baskets before Reeves' jumper trimmed the lead to 31-25 with 6:41 left in the second quarter.

Brielle Greenleaf then hit a 3-pointer for the Lady Blues, who outscored the Vikings by 11 over the remainder of the quarter. McKenzie Skaggs' layup at the buzzer gave the Lady Blues the 47-30 lead at the half.

Illinois College steadily pulled away and led 61-39 after three quarters, and the Lady Blues' biggest lead was the final margin.

in the game at Monmouth on Jan. 7. Minogue was putting together a solid freshman season, averaging 5.6 points and 2.5 rebounds per game while making six starts.

The Midwest Conference's top two teams, Cornell and Illinois College, made it tough on the Vikings last weekend. Lawrence was limited to just 42.5 points per game and heldto 26.9 percent shooting from the floor.

Rookie forward Shonell Benjamin (Brooklyn, N.Y./Latin School) averaged 8.0 rebounds in the two games last weekend to improve to a team-best 7.3 rebounds per game this season. That ranks sixth in the Midwest Conference. Benjamin had her fifth doubledigit rebounding game of the season when she pulled down 10 boards against Cornell. She



had a season-high Shonell Benjamin 14 rebounds vs. Wid-

ener on Dec. 17. Benjamin is averaging 4.1 points per game while shooting 30.6 percent from the floor.

Benjamin's work on the boards is one of the reasons the Vikings have been better on the glass in recent games. The Vikings out-rebounded Cornell 44-36 and a plus-2 in rebounding margin for the last three games.

▶If the Midwest Conference handed out a Most Improved Player Award, sophomore forward Leah Reeves (Lisle, III./ Lisle) would be at the top of the list of Leah Reeves contenders. Reeves leads the Vikings and



ranks 15th in the league in scoring at 10.2 points per game while shooting 40.7 percent from the floor. She's also second on the squad and ninth in the conference in rebounding at 6.1 per contest.

Senior Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./ East) leads the Vikings in 3-point shooting at 28.9 percent. She has made a team-best 13 3-pointers this season.

The Vikings rank ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 71.4 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in scoring at 47.6 points per game.

Lawrence is eighth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 39.1 percent. Lawrence is hitting 31 percent of its shots from the floor, and that ranks 10th in the conference.

The Vikings are third in the Midwest Conference in defending the 3-pointer at 27.8 percent. Lawrence is 10th in the conference in 3-point shooting at 23 percent.

SCOUTING LAKE FOREST

Lake Forest has lost three straight and dropped a 63-56 decision to visiting Knox this past Saturday. The Foresters have dropped eight of nine.

The top scorer for the Foresters is Bridget Bilek. She is the lone player averaging in double figures at 10.8 points per game.

Brittany Avonts is the top rebounder for the Foresters at 6.3 per game. The Foresters are averaging 40.8 rebounds per game and a minus-5.6 in rebounding margin.

Lake Forest is averaging 53.2 points per game, which ranks eighth in the conference. The Foresters are fifth in scoring defense at 58.5 points per contest.

Lake Forest ranks ninth in the conference in shooting at 31.7 percent. The Foresters are tops in the conference in field goal percentage defense at 33.8 percent.

The Foresters are shooting 26.4 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks seventh in the conference. The Foresters are the best team in the league at defending the 3-pointer at 25.5 percent.

SCOUTING BELOIT

▶Beloit saw its losing skid extend to nine games with a 59-43 defeat at visiting Grinnell last



Saturday. The Bucs travel to Cornell on Wednesday before they host Lawrence on Saturday.

Senior guard Laura Panicali is the top scorer for the Bucs at 11.2 points per game. She didn't play in Beloit's last game after being limited to just 16 minutes in the previous contest.

Nora Polaski also is averaging in double figures at 10.3 points per contest. Polaski is pulling down a team-best 5.0 rebounds per game.

Beloit is scoring 52 points per game, good for ninth in the league. The Bucs are seventh in scoring defense at 62.2 points per game.

▶ Beloit is shooting 38.3 percent from the floor, good for fifth in the conference. The Bucs are ninth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 41.9 percent.

Beloit is shooting 24.6 percent from 3-point range, and that ranks ninth in the conference. The Bucs are seventh in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 30.1 percent.
