## LAST GAME

Beloit steadily pulled away and scored a 73-39 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence on Saturday at Flood Arena.

Shelby Kline scored 19 points to lead three Beloit player in double figures.

Freshman Shonell Benjamin led Lawrence with eight points and pulled down a game-high 11 rebounds.

The game was tied 7-7 early when the Bucs started to run away. Beloit went on an 18-2 run, capped by a pair of Tegan Rock free throws, to lead 25-9.

Lawrence got baskets from Lauren Deveikis and Benjamin and a pair of free throws from Natalie Kramer to trim the lead to 28-15 at the half.

Beloit scored the first seven points of the second half to push the lead to 35-15. Lawrence chipped away at the lead and scored five consecutive points to cut the margin to 43-30 with 2:15 left in the third quarter.

The Bucs countered with an 8-1 run to build a 51-31 advantage. Lawrence didn't get closer than 18 points after that.

The Vikings' leading scorer, Leah Reeves, was limited to 12 minutes due to injury.

## VIKINGS UPDATE

► Injury continues to play havoc with the Vikings' rotation. After losing Grace Minogue (Chicago, Ill./Jones Prep) to a season-ending injury, the Vikings' also saw leading scorer Leah Reeves (Lisle, Ill./Lisle) go down. Reeves was limited to just 12 minutes in the game at Beloit this past Saturday. She is averaging 10 points and 5.8 rebounds per contest this season.



► Rookie forward Shonell Benjamin (Brooklyn, N.Y./Latin School) posted her sixth double-digit rebound game of the season when she grabbed 11 boards at Beloit this past Saturday. Benjamin, who had a season-high 14 rebounds vs. Widener in December,

is now averaging 7.5 rebounds per game. That ranks third in the Midwest Conference. Benjamin, who is averaging 4.3 points per game, has taken over the team lead in steals. She has 20 thefts on the season for an average of 1.3 per game.

► The Vikings have gone cold from the floor over the past four games. Lawrence hasn't shot better than 29.6 percent from the floor over the past four contests after shooting 36.3 percent during the five games prior to that. Lawrence also hasn't made more than

two 3-pointers during the last four games. Once again, during the five games prior to that, Lawrence averaged 5.2 3-pointers made per game and shot 28.6 percent from beyond the arc.

► Senior Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./East) continues to lead the Vikings in 3-point shooting at 28 percent. She has made a team-best 14 3-pointers this season. Scott is averaging 6.7 points and 4.2 rebounds per game.

► Junior guard Nicole Cummins (San Antonio, Texas/John Marshall) is tops on the squad at 2.1 assists per contest. Cummins is second on the squad at 1.1 steals per game.

► The Vikings rank ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 70.8 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in scoring at 46.5 points per game.

► Lawrence is eighth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 39.5 percent. Lawrence is hitting 30.3 percent of its shots from the floor, and that ranks 10th in the conference.

► The Vikings are fifth in the Midwest Conference in defending the 3-point-er at 28.5 percent. Lawrence is 10th in the conference in 3-point shooting at 21.3 percent.

## SCOUTING ST. NORBERT

► St. Norbert has been on a roll for more than a month. The Green Knights ran their win streak to eight games with a 68-48 victory over visiting Knox this past Saturday. The Green Knights haven't lost since a 70-59 defeat at Cornell back on Dec. 10. St. Norbert enters play this week two



games behind first-place Cornell in the Midwest Conference standings.

►Senior Brianna Byrne leads a balanced St. Norbert attack at 12.3 points per game while shooting 43.1 percent from the floor. She also is pulling down a team-best 4.5 rebounds per contest. Senior guard Regan Carmichael also is in double figures at 11.7 points per game.

►Senior guard Jill Kleiman leads the Green Knights and ranks third in the conference at 3.1 assists per contest. Kleiman also ranks second in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.8-to-1.

►St. Norbert is the top defensive team in the Midwest Conference and is allowing only 49.7 points per game. The Green Knights are scoring 64.1 points per game, which ranks fourth in the league.

►St. Norbert is shooting 40.7 percent from the floor, good for second in the league. The Green Knights are second in field goal percentage defense at 33.4 percent.

►St. Norbert is the top 3-point shooting team in the league at 35.1 percent. Byrne is shooting 47.5 percent from beyond the arc, and Carmichael has made a team-high 30 3-pointers. St. Norbert ranks fourth in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 28.3 percent.

### SCOUTING GRINNELL

►Grinnell is looking to bounce back after scoring a season-low 31 points in a 65-31 loss to visiting Ripon. The Pioneers play at Cornell on Wednesday before hosting the Vikings on Saturday.



►Junior forward Kayla Morrissey has been a dominant force under the basket and leads the team and the conference at 16.5 points per game while

shooting 44.3 percent from the floor. She also is tops on the team at 7.1 rebounds per contest.

►Grinnell is third in the league in scoring defense at 54.1 points per game. The Pioneers are ninth in scoring at 52.8 points per contest.

►Grinnell is shooting 31.8 percent from the floor, which ranks ninth in the conference. The Pioneers are fifth in field goal percentage defense at 37.1 percent.

►Grinnell is tops in the league in defending the 3-pointer at 25.1 percent. The Pioneers are shooting 25.4 percent from beyond the arc, and that ranks eighth in the conference. The team's top 3-point shooter is Sophia Gatton, who has made 19 3-pointers and is shooting 30.6 percent from beyond the arc.
