►Kyle Wilson (Hanover 2005) is in his first season at Monmouth and has a record of 2-17 (.105).

THE SERIES

►Ripon has a 53-28 advantage in a series that started in 1975-76, the first season of Lawrence basketball. The Red Hawks have won 18 straight against Lawrence.

►Monmouth has a 21-11 advantage over Lawrence in a series that started in the 1988-89 season. The Scots have won the last 17 meetings.

LAST GAME

Beloit pulled away in the third quarter this past Saturday and went on to a 64-40 Midwest Conference victory over Lawrence at Alexander Gymnasium.

The Bucs started to pull away late in the second quarter and then outscored Lawrence 13-5 in the third quarter to build a 43-21 advantage.

Melissa McLean scored 17 points off the bench and grabbed eight rebounds to pace Beloit.

Natalie Kramer led Lawrence with 13 points, and Olivia Hoesley and Lauren Deveikis added seven points apiece. Hoesley and Shonell Benjamin paced the Vikings with seven rebounds apiece.

Lawrence trailed by eight late in the second quarter, but the Bucs scored the final six points of the first half to grab a 30-16 lead at the break. The Vikings then went just 2-for-11 from the floor and committed five turnovers in the third quarter.

McLean scored five points in the third quarter for Beloit, and Nora Polaski and Shelby Kline added four points apiece. Kline finished with 16 points and Polaski added 12.

Beloit led by as many as 28 points early in the fourth quarter, but the Vikings put together a 10-3 run, highlighted by 3-pointers from Kramer and Deveikis, to close to 56-36. That's as close as Lawrence would get.

VIKINGS UPDATE

►The Vikings continue to face a roster depleted by injuries, but Lawrence did get leading scorer Leah Reeves (Lisle, Ill./Lisle) for a limited number of minutes against Beloit this past Saturday. Reeves missed three games before playing 15 minutes against the Bucs. Reeves scored just two points against Beloit and is now averaging 9.5 points and 5.4 rebounds per game on the season.

►While Reeves is working her way back into the lineup, the Vikings were

without swingman Aubrey Scott (Appleton, Wis./East) against Beloit. Scott was injured in the game at Cornell and was forced to sit out against the Bucs.

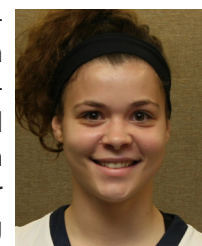
►Junior guard Olivia Hoesley (Eau Claire, Wis./North) saw her string of double-figure scoring games stopped at two, but she has averaged 13 points and 8.3 points over the past three contests. On the season, Hoesley is up to 8.6 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Hoesley is second on the team with 15 3-point-

ers this season, and Scott continues to lead the team in 3-pointers made (16) and 3-point shooting (28.6 percent).

►Junior guard Natalie Kramer (Mendota Heights, Minn./Sibley) has now scored in double figures in three of the last four games after scoring 13 points against Beloit. Over the past four games, Kramer is averaging 11 points and has improved to 6.2 points per game for the season.

►Rookie forward Shonell Benjamin (Brooklyn, N.Y./Latin School) has been the "size" in Lawrence's lineup lately and continues to do a great job on the glass. Benjamin ranks fifth in the Midwest Conference in rebounding at 7.3 per game. Benjamin also is averaging 4.5 points and 1.2 steals per game.

►The Vikings rank ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 70.6 points per game. The Vikings are 10th in scoring at 46 points per game.

►Lawrence is ninth in the league in field goal percentage defense at 40.3 percent. Lawrence is hitting 29.7 percent of its shots from the floor, and that ranks 10th in the conference.

►The Vikings are third in the Midwest Conference in defending the 3-point-er at 27.1 percent. Lawrence is 10th in the conference in 3-point shooting at 22.6 percent.

SCOUTING RIPON

►Ripon pushed its win streak to five games with a 62-49 victory over Lake Forest this past Saturday. Included in that win streak was a 55-50 win at St. Norbert and a 65-31 rout at Grinnell.



►Sophomore Maggie Oimoen continues to do damage inside and ranks

fourth in the Midwest Conference in scoring at 13.9 points per game while shooting 55 percent from the floor. Oimoen is also tops on the team in rebounding at 7.3 per game.

►Guards Emma McDonald and Megan Jensen are Ripon's top 3-point shooters. McDonald has hit a team-best 28 3-pointers while shooting 37.8 percent from beyond the arc. Jensen has made 24 3-pointers and is shooting a team-best 38.7 on 3-pointers.

►Ripon is averaging 63 points per game, good for fifth in the conference. The Red Hawks are fourth in scoring defense at 56.3.

►Ripon leads the league in shooting at 42.1 percent. The Red Hawks are second in field goal percentage defense at 33.9 percent.

►Ripon also leads the conference in 3-point shooting at 34.9 percent. Ripon is sixth in defending the 3-pointer at 30 percent.

SCOUTING MONMOUTH

►The Scots dropped their eighth straight with a 77-54 loss to visiting St. Norbert this past Saturday. Monmouth's last victory was a 72-57 win over Lawrence on Jan. 7.



►Monmouth travels to Cornell on Wednesday before visiting Lawrence on Saturday.

►Rebecca Gallis and Keri Dodson provide a 1-2 scoring punch for the Scots. Gallis is averaging a team-best 11.3 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor. Dodson is at 10.9 points per game and is tied with Maddie Dohleman for the team lead at 5.3 rebounds per game.

►Gallis is the top 3-point shooter on the squad as well. She has made 38 shots from beyond the arc and is shooting 38 percent on 3-pointers.
