

#### 1 Structure

This devotional<sup>1</sup> consists of an *Ordinary* four-week cycle repeated 12 times in the year. There are four *Celebratory* weeks marking Christmas, Holy Week, Easter Week, and Pentecost Week. An additional Advent Week completes the calendar when it is necessary.

The year starts on the Sunday before Christmas (12/18-24). There are 0-6 days of Ordinary Week 1 before Christmas Eve. The Christmas season runs for seven days, beginning with Christmas Eve Day. Then we fill out Ordinary Week 1 with 1-7 days. Ordinary Week 2 then occurs and the four-week cycle continues.

The 52 week cycle of 48 Ordinary Weeks and four Celebratory weeks ends on a Saturday; when that day occurs prior to December 17, we have an Advent Week before starting the next year.

#### 2 Order

#### Morning prayer.

- 1. In the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Repeat steps (a)-(d) for the first psalm, second psalm, and Old Testament reading.
  - (a) Reading
  - (b) Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end.
  - (c) Respond in Prayer.
  - (d) Repeat a phrase from the psalm as an antiphon.
- 3. The Gospel of our Lord. Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ.
- 4. The Gospel reading in its cycle.<sup>2</sup>
- 5. The Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.
- 6. Improvised litany.
- 7. The Canticle of Zachariah.
- 8. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end.
- 9. Our Father, Who art in heaven,..., deliver us from evil.
- 10. Prayer.
- 11. For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever.
- 12. May the Lord bless us, guide us, and keep us from sin this whole day.
- 13. In the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### Evening prayer.

- 3. The Gospel of our Lord. Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ.
- 4. The Gospel reading in its cycle.
- 5. The Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.
- 6. Improvised litany.
- 7. The Magnificat.
- 8. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end.
- 9. Our Father, Who art in heaven,..., deliver us from evil.
- 10. Prayer.
- 11. For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever.
- 12. May the Lord bless us, guide us, and keep us from sin this evening and night.
- 13. In the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

An *antiphon* is a phrase from the reading that stands as its own thought. An *improvised litany* involves phrases A, B, C from the reading and has the form

- (a) AB
- (b) ACB
- (c) Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
- (d) AB

Ideally, the meaning of A changes slightly when the C section is recited.

#### Canticle of Zachariah<sup>3</sup>.

Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because He has come to His people and redeemed them. He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of His servant David. As He said through His holy prophets of long ago, salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us to show mercy to our ancestors and to remember His holy covenant, the oath He swore to our father Abraham: to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve Him without fear in holiness and righteousness before Him all our days. And you, my child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go on before the Lord to prepare the way for Him, to give His people the knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins, because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace.
